

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter explains the conclusion of the study and the suggestion of the study.

A. Conclusion

As mentioned above, there are three research problems in this study. The answer of the first research problem is that the quality of students' translation is less accurate but it is acceptable. It can be shown from the average score that is found 2 in accuracy and 3 in acceptability criteria. The result shows that 41% sentences are accurate, 24% sentences are less accurate and 35% sentences are inaccurate. On the other hand, the acceptability percentage in Taj Mahal shows that 64% sentences are acceptable, 30% sentences are less acceptable and 6% sentences are unacceptable. While in Cuban Rondo, the result shows that 44% sentences are accurate, 26% sentences are less accurate and 30% sentences are inaccurate. On the other hand, the acceptability percentage shows that 83% sentences are acceptable, 8% sentences are less acceptable and 9% sentences are unacceptable.

The second research problem is to find out the translation procedures used by the students in translating. It is found that all the students used only literal procedure to translate the descriptive texts. It is also answered the third research problem that is to find out the research method used by the students. It is found that both descriptive texts, Taj Mahal and Cuban Rondo, are translated by the students using literal method.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusions above, the researcher recommends some suggestion for the student, teacher and for the future researcher in the following below:

1. For the student.

The students should read carefully before translating the texts and make sure that all the sentences are translated, so they will not get inaccurate translation.

2. For the teacher.

The teacher should explain to the students about the criteria of accurate and acceptable translation. Explaining the criteria of translation will help the students get the better result.

3. For further researcher.

Managing time as good as possible and analyzing carefully are very recommended for the next researcher because there will be a lot of data to be analyzed and it consumes lots of time.
