

BAB V

CONCLUSION

This chapter describes the conclusion of the research and the suggestion to the certain parties that are related to this research. Here is the description of this chapter:

A. Conclusion

This research has been done through some steps to reveal the answers of the research problem that is concluded in this part. The part of conclusion includes the students' reading comprehension before and after treated with short comics and the results of the effectiveness of short comics as a media in teaching reading comprehension on the eleventh grade students of SMAN 5 Taruna Brawijaya, Kota Kediri.

1. The Students' Reading Comprehension before Treated with Short Comics

From the summary of pretest result, the researcher knows that the mean score of experimental group is 37.98 with the highest score is 72.70 and the lowest score is 22.70. The mean of students' reading comprehension score is under standard of minimum competencies (KKM) of the subject.

2. The Students' Reading Comprehension after Treated with Short Comics

Short comics media gave an effect on students' reading text. It is proven by the result of posttest conducted by the researcher after giving the

treatment in each class. From the descriptive statistics result, it can be seen that the mean score of experimental group is 83.13 and the mean score of control group is 80.20. Compared to before treatment, the mean score of posttest is significantly higher than pretest (score = 37.9) where the range between pretest and posttest mean is 45.23.

3. The Effectiveness of Short Comics Media to Improve Students' Reading Comprehension

Based on the result of research finding and discussion in the previous chapter, short comics media gives significant effect on students' reading comprehension achievement which means that short comics is effective as media in teaching and learning process in order to improve students' reading comprehension. The ANCOVA test result statistic value shows .000 which is lower than probability value .05 ($.000 < .05$). according to that statistic value, the researcher concludes that teaching reading comprehension using short comics as a media is effective.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion that has been described, the researcher would like to give suggestion to some parties. They are the students, the teachers or lecturers, and the further researcher.

1. For the students

For the students, it is important to have motivation in teaching and learning process because the teacher has been providing the media in order to help students motivation and understanding. The students should follow the

teacher's instruction related to the teaching and learning process. In relation to the reading comprehension, the teacher still finds a number of students who have low reading achievement, so the students should improve their reading skill and do some activities which may help their ability to comprehend the skill.

2. For the teachers

For the teachers or lecturers who teach English especially in reading comprehension course. Looking at the result shows that short comics is effective in improving students reading comprehension achievement, it may help the teacher to give a drawn about media used in the teaching and learning process. But, the teacher should be selective in selecting the pictures and story related to the topic of teaching and learning in the classroom because it may lead to the result of the students.

3. For the further researcher

The results of this research give a contribution for the research in the same field. Moreover, those results complete the result from previous studies which supply reinforcement and also variation of the same research topic. Additionally, this research only investigates the eleventh grade of senior high school students. That is why, the researcher suggests to the further researcher to make a research wider and vary the research instruments for the validity and reliability of the research. Furthermore, the next researcher can build up new other variable that is not exact in this study to strengthen and embody this kind of research.
