#### **CHAPTER I**

- 2. Debate is a formal discussion on particular matter in a public meeting or legisltive assembly, in which opposing arguments are put forward and which usually ends with a vote.
- 3. US president candidate is two persons from differents party who will be a president of US which replaced the position president before them to continuing the program from government and make new program for next period, and always doing with election and vote.
