A. Conclusion

In this research, the researcher does analysis on using speech act in USA President candidate debate 2016. The researcher analyze about the types of speech act and the function of speech act using in this debate. According to Austin theory, the researcher classified the data with three types of speech act. There are locutionary act, illocutionary act, and perlocutionary act. Researcher finds 69 data of speech act according Austin theory in this debate. There are 21 locutionary act, 25 perlocutionary act, and 23 illocutionary act.

Because this is debate, so the using of perlocutionary acts is more than another types of speech act according Austin theory.
