CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion is drawn based on the formulated research problems, and the suggestion is expected to give some information for the next researchers who are interested in conducting a research in the same field.

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings, the conclusion of this research can be drawn as follows. The interrogative sentences in *The Hound of The Baskervilles* on novel by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle use the four types of illocution. They are directive, representatives, commisive and expressive. But the declarative do not use in this field analysis. The types of directives illocution used in this field analyses are questioning, requesting, ordering, and suggesting. Besides, the types of representatives illocution used by interrogative sentences in novel are affirming, concluding, and predicting. Meanwhile, the types of commisive acts used in this field analyses is offering. In addition, the types of this expressive acts used by interrogative sentences in *The Hound of The Baskervilles* on novel by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle is criticize. The most frequent types used by interrogative sentences in *The Hound of The Baskervilles* on novel by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle is directives.

B. Suggestion

The researcher realizes there are some mistake in this study about contents and any other. So the researcher hopes critic and suggestion to complete this study. Concerning the topic of this research, there are some suggestions to be given. It is suggested to the next researchers to use the other part of illocution as functions of illocution in analyzing interrogatives in *The* Hound Of The Baskervilles On Novel By Sir Arthur Conan Doyle or others. The other object of study for future investigation can also be used, such as: the dialogues found in both formal and informal interview. It is also suggested to the next researchers to use other illocutionary acts theories to do an investigation on the same field of research. And the next contributes knowledge in pragmatics and discourse studies. This research suggests that the illocutionary intent can be achieved in various ways, and a way can be used to achieve a variety of goals or illocutionary intent. English learners will be expecting to gain a better understanding of ways to convey meaning in communication and this study provides information to the teachers and students in discourse studies and pragmatics.
