

CHAPTER II

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

This chapter dedicated to discuss the review to related literature and the theories of the study. It describe about song lyric, paraphrase, moral value, moral concept in islam, Harris J.

A. Song Lyric

Lyric come from Ancient Greece has means a piece for single voice, to be accompanied by the lyre. The song lyric is specifically intended for singing. This intention affects diction, content and stanza form. The song lyric is particularly unified and simple. A tune has its own emotional character, and it is words will need to be of words and music¹. Song lyric is the verbal symbol that created by human. Human is the creature that knows how to react not only in the physical environment but also in the symbols.

From the explanation above, it can be concluded that song lyric is symbolic reaction of humans. It is a response of everything that happened and felt by their physical environment and it is influenced by common sense and rationality. Symbol is used by human to understand a reality cannot be seen directly, but it can be seen and felt by human senses. This stimulus is processed and created by mind. Then, the concept or the

specific interpretation will be formed a specific meaning appropriate with what will be pronounced.

B. Paraphrase

A paraphrase of the Book of Daniel placing in parallel prophecy and interpretation phrase. A paraphrase is a restatement of the meaning of a text or passage using other words. The term itself is derived meaning "additional manner of expression". The act of paraphrasing is also called to "paraphrases". A paraphrase typically explains or clarifies the text that is being paraphrased. For example, "The signal was red" might be paraphrased as "The train was not allowed to pass because the signal was red". A paraphrase is usually introduced with *verbum dicendi* a declaratory expression to signal the transition to the paraphrase. For example, in "The signal was red, *that is*, the train was not allowed to proceed," the *that is* signals the paraphrase that follows.

A paraphrase does not need to accompany a direct quotation, the paraphrase typically serves to put the source's statement into perspective or to clarify the context in which it appeared. A paraphrase is typically more detailed than a summary. Paraphrase may attempt to preserve the essential meaning of the material being paraphrased. Thus, the (intentional or otherwise) reinterpretation of a source to infer a meaning that is not explicitly evident in the source itself qualifies as "original research," and not as paraphrase.

The term is applied to the genre of Biblical paraphrases, which were the most widely circulated versions of the Bible available in medieval Europe. Here, the purpose was not to render an exact rendition of the meaning or the complete text, but to present material from the Bible in a version that was theologically orthodox and not subject to heretical interpretation, or, in most cases, to take from the Bible and present to a wide public material that was interesting, entertaining and spiritually meaningful, or, simply to abridge the text. The phrase "in your own words" is often used within this context to imply that the writer has rewritten the text in their own writing style - how they would have written it if they had created the idea².

Two expressions that describe the same situation, each is considered to be a paraphrase of the other. There is no precise paraphrase definition in general; instead there are frequently-accepted paraphrasing patterns to which various authorities refer. Academic writing centers (ASU Writing Center, 2000; BAC Writing Center; USCA Writing Room; and Hawes, 2003) provide a number of characterizations, such as using synonyms, changing part-of-speech, reordering ideas, breaking a sentence into smaller ones, using definitions, and using examples. McNamara (in press), on the other hand, does not consider using definitions or examples to be part of paraphrasing, but rather considers them elaboration.

Stede(1996) considers different aspects or intentions to be paraphrases if they mention the same content or situation.

Instead of attempting to find a single paraphrase definition, we will start with six commonly mentioned paraphrasing patterns: 1). Synonym: substitute a word with its synonym, e.g. help, assist, aid, 2) Voice: change the voice of sentence from active to passive or vice versa; 3) Word-Form/Part-of-speech: change a word into a different form, e.g. change a noun to a verb, adverb, or adjective; 4) Break down Sentence: break a long sentence down into small sentences; 5) Definition/Meaning: substitute a word with its definition or meaning; 6) Sentence Structure: use different sentence structures to express the same thing.

If the explanation has any additional information or misses some information that appeared in the original sentence, we should be able to detect this as well for use in discovering additional strategies employed.³ According to Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary paraphrase is expressing the meaning of something using different words, especially to achieve greater clarity.

C. Moral

Moral refers to what is good or bad people's relation to others. In other words, understanding the morality is good or bad and right or wrong.

The morality refers to good or right in interpersonal or social situation.

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Social relationship can be judged by standards such as efficiency or produce⁴. Moral issues involve a way of behaving and having character, they are unavoidably coming in all shapes and sizes. Fundamentally, moral issues arise when the choice that people take will affect the good attitude of other by increasing or decreasing. For example, when other people are watching news in program television about criminal, it is can be a source to be more careful and getting on the ball with criminal. The negative or decreasing attitude is when the other people make it to be the source of their criminal.

Moral comes from the Latin word *mores*, it has meaning of custom and folkways. Moral behavior means behavior in conformity with the moral code of the social group. Moral development has both an intellectual and an impulsive aspect, people must learn what is right and wrong and must be given explanation of why this is right and wrong.

A morality according to Edward in the Encyclopedia of Philosophy, states that morality are: Beliefs about the nature of man, Beliefs about ideals, about with is good or desirable or worthy of pursuit for its own sake, Rules laying down what ought to be done and what ought not to be done and Motive that incline us to choose the right or the wrong course. There are three kinds of motives which lead men to act morally, that is, to obey the moral rules of their society, enlightened self-interest, respect for rules, and other regarding motives. According to Betham as

mentioned in Hazlitt morality is the art of maximizing happiness. It can be seen by reaching the existence of happy and joyful life of humans.

Morals are the standards by which behaviors are evaluated for their morality their rightness or wrongness. Morality is something that must be owned by human because without morality human will not be respected by other people. They will be easy to socialize with people around them and will be accepted in the community. Someone who has moral should have the ability to consider good and bad behavior because no one can live without other person.

According to Carol K. Sigelman, the term “morals” implies an ability: (1) to distinguish right from wrong, (2) to act on this distinction, and (3) to experience pride when one does the right thing and guilt or shame when one does not. Carol K. Sigelman, also stated that there are three basic components of morality⁵. They are: An affective or emotional component, a cognitive component, A behavioral component.

An affective or emotional component contains the feelings of guilt concern for other feelings that surround right or wrong actions and that motivate thoughts and actions. A cognitive component focuses on the way we conceptualize right and wrong and make decisions about how to behave. A behavioral component reflects how we actually behave when for example we do or have something that we know is bad or wrong, or help a needy person.

D. Values

The theory of value begins with a subject matter. It is hard to specify in some general way exactly what counts, but it certainly includes what people are talking about. According to Ursery stated value is belief or attitude about what is good, right desirable, worthwhile and value system the ways people organize rank, prioritize, and make decision. Based on the people values provide the foundation from which the people make the personal and professional judgment and choices. The writer concludes they are the people beliefs about what is important in life. Some values refer to how one should act. Other values refer to what one wants to accomplish or obtain in life.

According Schroeder gives some distribution of value in daily life, he explains pleasure is good or bad; it would be good or bad if people did that. He gives another examples of value those are too much cholesterol is good or bad for health; it is better or worse for it to end now, than for us to get caught later⁶. Value are guidance to act or behave which coming from ourselves, principles about to live a life and to make a decision .Values are moral and nature of behaviour which are decided for ourselves, involved the concept of universal truth, honesty, fair, justice and honor.

According to Earle, value is positive quality of anything whereby it is desirable, useful, interesting, good, and important. Only a few of the terms is available for the expression of positive values. Whether values are

part of the intrinsic nature of things or simply a matter of how humans respond to things is controversial. It is clear that the values influence what people will determine as ethical; however, values are the measure of importance, whereas ethics represent judgments about right and wrong.

The researcher can conclude, values is close relationship between importance and right and wrong is a powerful influence on behavior and how the people evaluate the behaviour of others.

E. Moral Values

Moral values has been learned and taught since childhood. It is the first step to be a good person. Behavior is the way of behaving. Good behaviors is shown by how someone presented the politeness, for example speaks politely, dressed politely, and walks politely and etc.

According Ursery moral values are the people beliefs about what is important in life.⁷ Some values refer to how one should act such as become honest, altruistic, self-discipline while other moral value to what one wants to accomplish or obtain in life. Moral values are quite or not specific about what should be done. It is general beliefs or attitudes about something the people desire or like.

Bertens theory moral value is value that must be separated with other values.⁸ Every value will get quality if it has relation with other

values. Moral values are characterized they are Responsibility, Conscience, Obligation, Formality.

a. Responsibility

Moral values related to the human person who is responsible.

A moral value only is realized in actions that are fully the responsibility of the person concerned. Humans themselves become a source of moral values.

b. Conscience

Value always contains some sort of invitation or appeal. Moral value is that only raising the value of the voice of conscience that accused persons when underestimate or against moral values and praised us when realizing moral values.

c. Obligation

Moral values that are required for granted unconditionally. These values apply to humans as humans. Expected and even demanded that everyone uphold moral values and practice. Moral obligation does not come from the outside or institutions but is rooted in people's own humanity.

d. Formality

Moral value is not stand-alone without other value. Moral values did not separate with other values. Moral values are nothing

without other values. It is form of formality. Max Scheler mentioned in Bertens that moral values “get a lift” to other values⁹.

Religion also gives many contributions in moral values development. Someone who has religion, they should control their act and attitude because in the Holy Qur’an there are prohibitions, commands, and punishment. Barcalow suggest that many people appeals to God’s Law the ultimate test of right and wrong. It can be understood that religion is a foundation of moral values¹⁰.

1. Types of Moral Values

Types of moral values are Religiosity, Love and Affection, Loyalty, Sincerity, Thankfulness, Steadfastness, Humbleness, Peace loving, Brotherhood, Respecting others, and Optimism.

a. Religiosity

Religiosity is morbid or excessive concern with religion in it is formal expression. Religiosity can be defined as exaggerated embodiment of certain aspects of religious activity. Religiosity is characterized by excessive involvement in religious activities.

b. Love and Affection

Love as a concept enters philosophy at one point through religion, particularly when the origin of the world is expressed as an act of procreation or the Creator is conceived of as loving his creation either as a whole or in part (i.e. the human race). But the

Dear to themselves is more than just a loyal and respectful. Dear friends, dear to the neighbor, who also love to hate us. And emphasize the lifelong responsibility for saying to the family.

c. Loyalty

Loyalty means reliable and consistent in implementing, always support, serve and help. Loyalty is not only always supported what he do but also give warned about the mistake that have been made. Loyalty refers to the quality of another to have unwavering to another person. It is a state in which an individual executes his or her mandate to the letter, with strict adherence to and faithfulness to a sovereign.

d. Sincerity

Sincerity is the quality of honestly believing something or really meaning what you say. Sincerity is the virtue of one who speaks and acts truly about his or her own feelings, thoughts, and desires.

e. Thankfulness.

Thankfulness is word or action that expresses gratitude to someone or something

f. Steadfastness.

Steadfastness is being certain that you are right about something and refusing to change the position or opinion in anyway.

g. Humbleness

Aware that a friendly and carrying attitude is more commendable than a rough attitude. The tendency to use instead of confrontation. Tenderness, especially to the younger and weaker. Capable of making new friends and maintaining friendship. Lightweight hand to help. Humbleness means approving, but not considering yourself or ideas to be more important than other people or their ideals.

h. Peace loving

Peace loving means controlling emotions and keep them from injuring others things. Peace loving does not mean that emotion should be eliminated or ignored, it is called value as to be good for others and for oneself so as to feel and function better. Peace loving is something that can be transmitted.

i. Brotherhood

Brotherhood means a feeling of friendship between people.

Brotherhood is that treating others as though they are part of the family that love and support. It means lending a hand or helping to carry a burden for another when someone can.

j. Respecting others

Respecting other means showing the special esteem or consideration in which one holds another person or thing. It is like; salute to life, respect to property right, respect for the father and mother, respect for elders, respect for nature and respect for the belief and right of the others. Showing civilized and polite behavior is also respectful. Avoiding unhealthy or harmful distractions to yourself is a form of respect to yourself. Respecting others means to admire someone because they have high standard and good personal quality.

k. Optimism

Optimism is having a tendency to believe that good things will always happen and the future will be good. It is a tendency to look at the bright side of any situation and expect the best possible outcome from any series of events. Optimism is powerfully motivational; it is one of the cornerstones of success.

CHAPTER III

METHOD OF RESEARCH

This chapter explains the methodology in which the researcher used in his research. Topics includes research design, object of the research, data source, data collection, data analysis and triangulation.

A. Research Design

Qualitative research method is used approach are characterized by the assumption that the researcher's biases and perspectives must be understood and included in interpreting findings.¹¹ Another method applied in this research is a descriptive which is useful in describing the facts and phenomenon. The describes and interprets what conditions or relation that exists, opinions that are held, processes that are going on, effects that are evident or trends that are developing.

The researcher uses descriptive qualitative. So, the researcher wants to give complete information about this topic. Those are Harris J song deal with morality aspect of life in order to be able to catch by the listeners and readers imagination. To make easier, the researcher uses paraphrase to find the content moral values of the Harris J songs lyric. The paraphrase is through retelling used the researcher opinion on the text or lyrics of the songs.

After finishing the paraphrase, it will be gotten a unity of intact story from the songs. After that, the researcher concluded moral values that existed

B. Object of research

The research object of this study are six song Harris J concerned to the discussed. They are *SalamAlaikum, Worth it, I promise, The One, Good Life and Rosull Allah*. These songs are included into first album which taken from Haris J. The album is released on August 31, 2015. This album is labeled Awakening Records UK.

C. Data Source

Terms data refers to materials researcher collect of the research is the lyrics of Harris J songs. The Subject of the research is the text lyrics of Harris J songs. The rough materials which were taken from among the material and put it as the main or primary source are five songs among the other songs which in song of Harris J (*Salam Alaikum, Worth, I Promise, The One, Good Life and Rosull Allah*) which are basically dominated by English language.

We can take the data *from* them because each song has its own explanation. And from the song there are many some languages that consist of some words. From those words the researcher studied and those words can be a primary data of this research because from these words the researcher can analyze the moral values in the song.

D. Data Collection

To process the data the first step is downloading the text lyrics of Harris Jsongs via internet was conducted on June 10nd, 2015. The second, researcher listened to those Semi Yusuf's songs that will be described. The last, researcher read any information about the background of the song. After that the researcher chooses five of songs that *Salam Alaikum, Worth it, I promise, The One, Good Life and Rosull Allah*. Because the researcher found good inspiring and good moral values in this song.

E. Data Analysis

After collecting data the researcher tries to analyze the data by some steps. The first uses the internet facility the researcher complete data and can gain the data of the theory. The second, the researcher reviewing the theories that will be used to analyze. The third, analyzing the song. The researcher uses paraphrasing to know the story of the song. After finishing paraphrase, the researcher finds the moral values that existed on the six songs: *Salam Alaikum, Worth it, I promise, The one, Good Life and Rosull Allah*. The paraphrases and moral values message will be read in chapter IV. And the last, after paraphrasing and finding moral values the researcher gives the conclusion, which will be read in chapter V.

CHAPTER IV

RESEARCH FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

In this chapter, the researcher has found the data that will be described based on the theory on Chapter II. Here the researcher describes about moral values in Harris J song lyric. The researcher analyzes moral values in five songs of Harris J. After listening, the researcher describes the paraphrase of the song's lyric to find the moral values.

A. Finding the paraphrases of Harris J's songs

In this addition, the researcher analyzes moral values in five songs lyric of Harris J. Moral values are the standards that help us determine what kinds of action are proper and worthwhile and which are not, what is right and or wrong, and good and or bad. In the Harris J song lyric the researcher found the moral values delivered by the singer. Before finding the moral values, the researcher describes the paraphrase of song's lyric as discussed in the following:

1. Paraphrase of Harris J song's

The researcher tries to make paraphrasing the songs by Harris J. The aim of Paraphrases are to help find some moral values in song lyric. The researcher describes paraphrasing consist of six songs titled *Salamalaikum*, *Worth it*, *Theone*, *Good life There*, *in Rosul Allah*

a. Paraphrase in “ *Salam alaikum* “

With had a good time we can go have fun and meet with the people we love and we could say hello. In Islam, Salam is one of the root word of Islam, which means peace and spread peace and salvation. Salam is also the wonderful name of Allah SWT.

*I just want to spread love and peace
And all of my happiness, yeah
To everyone I that meet
'Cause I'm feeling spectacular
I love it when we love one another
Give thanks every day
For this life, living with a smile on our face
AssalamuAlaikum, Alaikum yeah!
(Peace be upon you)*

This part of second stanza tells us about; (*I just want to spread love and peace and all of my happiness, yeah to everyone I that meet.*) when he meets someone by saying Salam because word of greeting is not just an

expression of affection, but provide the reasons and logic affection embodied in the form of a prayer of hope so you are safe from all kinds of grief-suffering. And also pray for the Salam meaning of life with goodness. Salam reminds us that we all depend on Allah SWT.

*Spread peace on the earth
Cherish the love, that is around us
Spread peace on the earth
Treasure the love, let it surround us
Always be kind, always remind one another
Peace on the earth everyday
AssalamuAlaikum, Alaikum yeah!
(Peace be upon you)*

No creature that can harm or benefit to anyone, without the approval of Allah. Notice that when someone tells you, "I pray that you prosper." So he stated and promised that you are safe from the hands of (treatment), tongue (spoken), and he will respect the right to life, dignity, and your self-esteem.

b. Paraphrase in "Worth it"

When he experienced the hard life he never stops working he remains eager to do the job because he knows when it wanted something it was not easy to get it. Not enough to work hard but accompanied with a prayer that God always simplify matters that are beingfaced.

In this stanza tells us about the writer who had to be patient to get the dream he will not to hurry to get his dream that in accordance with his

What he needs is to be done to continue and enjoy the process toward his dream by following every process also requires patience and sincerity and also fought hard never give up in the face of all the obstacles that occur on the way to the success. After passing through each stage, we'll be success of our definite winner. When someone has a dream they have to fight to get their dreams comes true. Realize his dream and that dream will come true when someone is trying and is sure to get his dream. Because when he confident and believes on himself and think positively he will get the dream he wants.

 If you just believe then one day you'll see, yeah!
 When I'm on the case I know it's worth it

 Now it's time to put all of the work in, yeah!*

The last stanza tells about he is now closer to the dream that he wanted and he was working hard again to really achieve his dreams. And believe in God who always guide and give the strength to get his dream. When he was working hard to achieve his dreams, there are so much people who waste their times and does not care about his future. Meanwhile, there are still many people who wants to fight for their dreams, and no matter they face the dark night, they will not give up, and still want to realize their dreams.

c. Paraphrase in “*I promise* song “

The table above proves there are types of moral values analysed with the total of 38 items throughout all the 6 songs. The most frequently found is in Love and Affection type with total 8 items. The least found is in Respecting Other type with total 1 item. The most frequently found type is Love and Affection with 21.05% and the least found is Respecting Other with 2.63%. There is one type of moral value that could not be found by the researcher which is Brotherhood.

In this addition, the main discussion is moral values analysis of Harris J song's lyric. The researcher tried to describe the story of song lyric

in the chosen five song. The researcher found in the song have some moral values, those are : thanks to God, love to God, love to prophet Muhammad, patient, optimist, strong, helpfull, forgive and love. The detail of the moral values of those songs and the meaning of statement are in the following:

1. Moral Values in “ Salam Alaikum “

To make the reseacher easy to describe the moral values in the song, it is divided the song into stanza. From the stanza the researcher will describe every moral values that included in the stanza itself. The first analysis is Salam alaikumsong. The reseacher found moral values of lyrics and it shown the data in the table below:

As stated in Surah Al Baqarah verse 286, *“God will not burden a person but according capability”*.

The lyric *“with You right here I’ll be OK ? ‘Cause everything about You is the truth”*, means that he always believes when he worships Allah, he will feel ease to live her life and feel that Allah will always be there when she needs him. He believed in God and the truth about it and to worship him. He also believes that Allah always give the best for his people who believe in the truth of Allah and God will not give trouble to his servants who close to him and always ask for his help.

The existence of God is very clear. This can be shown by the arguments of reason, HISSI (sensory), or nature and the arguments of the shari'ah. Proposition sense showed the presence of God, because all the creatures in various form which is certainly God's Creature. There is no creature that was holding himself or just there by itself with no one creates. All creatures have been created to have faith in his creator without having taught previously and no creature turned away from the nature of it. It is based on the words of the Prophet sallallaahu 'alaihiwasallam, *"Every child is born in a state of fitrah (Islam, Eid), then that's his old man made the Jews, Christians, and Zoroastrians"* (HR. Bukhari and Muslim).

The last lyric *"Whenever I call out Your Name Lift up my hands, bow down to pray"*, means that he always adores the name of Allah when he worships him and he always raised his hands in time to worship and pray to the gods. He is always asking for help to Allah to live this life because he believes that Allah can give help when he got trouble. By way of praying we get closer to god Because Allah is always near and help a man who wants to draw closer to him. The best way to communicate with Allah is by calling his name lifting up hands and being contemptible.

Pray is one of self-purification and coaching. This is mentioned by Allah, "Successful indeed are those who purify the soul, and actually lost the person who contaminated". (QS, ash-Shams: 9-

10). Purification of the soul takes place with prayer and tawassul to Allah SWT. Solely prayer educate and purify human beings.

5. Moral Values in “ *Good life* “ song

The reseacher will describe the moral values in the song dividing the song into stanzas. Then, from the stanza the researcher will describe every moral that included in the stanza itself. The last analysis is *Good life* song. The reseacher findssomemoralvalues of the lyricand explains itinthetablebelow:

The moral values in this song is about thankfulness. The first line in the first stanza "*Good life, good life Allah I want to thank You for the good life*", means that he is happy in his world and he wants always to thank God for all that is given to him. Without Allah he could not feel happiness and peace in his life that all come from God. That is why he is always grateful for what is given and always leaned to his God.

It is truly a must for us to thank to God Almighty by carrying out the obligations to it. Every Muslim must give thanks in behalf of favor. If someone who does not carry out obligation to others, then he is the one who does not know how to *be* grateful. Allah says in surah Al Baqarah, "*So remember it to me, I will remember you. Give thanks to me, and do not disbelieve me*". (Al-Baqarah: 152).

The third stanza, "*I leave it all in Your hands, oh. Thank You for the good life, good life*", tells about his belief that every happiness in this life is from Allah. He believe the destiny of his life and God would provide the best. This lyric also tells that humans who are always surrender to God will have a positive energy that motivates him to achieve life goals.

When a servant put my trust in God with a real sincere and continue to remember the majesty of God, then the hearts and minds and all his power will be stronger push to do all the deeds. With the

tremendous trust in God, a person will have great *confidence*. As Allah ta'ala says (which means): *"And if Allah afflict you with a hazard then nothing can uncover but Him, and if He wants goodness for you then no one can resist the virtue of him. God inflicted calamity to whomever He wills, and He is the Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful."* (Qur'an, Yunus: 107).

By choosing itself on the belief that only God can give, then a believer would not be cowed and afraid of challenges and tests that hit, no matter how big, because he *believed* that God would help His servants who try and leaned his heart only to God. With such a strong belief, a true servant appears to be the defender of Islam who always leans on Allah although facing a big test. They are even willing to sacrifice body and soul to the sake of Islam.

The stanza *"That the more I learn I want to leave it all in Your hands 'Cause I know You'll always take good of care of me You've given me a good life, a good life each day"*, Tells that he learned much about sincere to live his life and he believed in god and destiny that was best for him. He understands that all events must contain a favor. Thus, they will be detached from anything that is not useful, never despair, and continue to get what they want. By believing in destiny that is given Allah we will have a strong heart and independence in taking Decree of. By believing in destiny that is given from the God, all material and worldly affairs will be organized. We will live a life

on the right path without a doubt, anxiety, and worries. But to draw closer to God, we must realize that the best of way is just submit our self to god no matter what.

*"And Allah belong the dominion of the heavens and the earth, and to Allah is the return (of all things)", (SurahAnnur 42).*The meaning of surah An-nur is to encourage us to surrender because Allah is the best place to lean and the only one that will bring us to the degree of resignation.

The last stanza *"It's about being thankful and trying to, That the more I learn I want to leave it all in Your hands"*, tells that he is grateful and learn to understand that leaning on God is the best for him and he also learn to surrender to Allah. He learns to accept the situation and never complain and feel confused when she was facing difficulties in life. He wants to surrender to God by believing and realizing that God always gives him the best.

When we hit a bad thing, Allah Almighty says in the Qur'an, *"He who trusts in God, know that Allah is Mighty, Wise."* (Surat al-Anfal [8]: 49). *Tawakkal* to God means we have to represent the trust in him when a heartbreaking event befall. Thus, we must surrender ourselves when disaster strikes, be patient when grief *happens* in life, and be grateful for every episode of life full of positive expectations. There are a variety of positive benefits which can be obtained from resignation to God and glory that looks at a person is merely the fruit

of submission to Him. Someone who has totality resignation will not rely on others but Allah. Allah is the only one he will always depend and surrender. Therefore, full confidence in God can relieve anxiety and restlessness because when we in very happy condition, it will not feel so proud and when happiness is gone, it will not be too anxious.

6. Moral Values in “Rosull Allah” song

The researcher will describe the moral values in the song by dividing the song into stanzas. Then, from the stanza the researcher will describe every moral that included in the stanza itself. The last analysis is *Rosull Allah* song. The researcher finds some moral values and show data in the table below:

The first stanza “*Yourlight is always showing me the Rasool’Allah, Habib’Allah I’m longing for the day I see your face*” tells that prophet Muhammad is the prophet of Muslims can bring us to the right path to get to Allah. Prophet Muhammad is the last prophet Allah sent to guide his people to the beaten path and show the best for the people who believe in it. When he uttered the name of the prophet Muhammad SAW, it seemed that prophet Muhammad presents in front of him. A person with the level of the high love towards Prophet could present to him directly or through a dream. This stanza describes the love of a Muslim to his prophet and it also says that he miss him so much and really want to meet him so much. Humans desperately need the message of God, Prophet Muhammad PBUH. Without him, undoubtedly there will be no good in the world.

Thus, although the reason could discern what is right and what is wrong, but he was not able to understand in greater depth and detail.

Intellect also cannot figure out implementation procedures of worship, unless assisted by the revelations and explained by the Prophet's message. So there is no other way to achieve happiness and fortune. Nothing in the world and the hereafter, except through the Messenger of Allah that can be a way to distinguish the good and the bad except through the Apostles. Whoever turns away from the message of the Prophets and Messengers, then he will experience very strong distress, anxiety, and suffering in accordance with the attitude of antipathy.

The second stanza about moral value of sincerity "*You brighten up my day Oohh. And in my heart you'll stay Oo*", tells about the Prophet Muhammad who always give the brightness of each day to his people because it shows the right way to get closer to Allah. And he always remembers the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad. He never forgets the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad which is why as believers, we must love and glorify it. This love will grow in us if we truly believe, if our faith is not intact, then we are not going to love the Prophet Muhammad.

God's messenger revelation is given to teach the religion of Islam and spread it to his people. A religion that is permitted by God so that he will never leave and always follow the teaching he needs to say to muslim as the light of life.

"O Prophet! We have sent you to be a witness, and a bearer of glad tidings and a warner. And to be a caller to the religion of Allah

with his permission and to be the light that illuminates "(QS. Al Ahzab; 45-46). *SiraajulMuniir* here means "the light" because God gave the prophet the great revelation (Al Qur'anulKarim and Sunnah). Because God gives instructions (Al Qur'anulKarim and Sunnah) towards the straight path, and with both of them also provide instructions to the people to the goodness. So the Prophet Shallallahu'alaihiWassalam is the light and comes with illumination, but that does not mean he was created from light.

The third stanza "*With every breath I take Oohh...I'll never leave your way.*" tells about the Prophet Muhammad that is always felt in every breath due to her current life and this favor from God. He never forget the teachings of the prophet Muhammad that always bring his people to the God and conduct him to the beaten path and always pray to God and believe in the Qur'an. He always believed in the Qur'an and understand about holy Qur'an. By doing this, he will feel the closeness with his god as good as the closeness to Prophet Muhammad Puh.

When people believe in the Messenger of God, this also means to trust and to believe in all of the Prophet Muhammad's teaching. Allah says in Al Qur'an, "*O those who believe, still believe in Allah and His Messenger and the Book that Allah sent down to His Messenger, and the Book which Allah has sent down before. Anyone who disbelieve in Allah, His angels, His book books, his apostles, and*

the Last Day, then indeed the man had gone far astray." [An-Nisa ': 136]. In the verses above, Allah commanded the believers to believe in Allah, His Messenger, the Qur'an and the previously revealed scriptures. It is an obligation of faith to the apostles.

And this stanza also about moral value of affection. This lyric tells about his feeling of peace in following the teachings of Islam through Prophet Muhammad that always draw closer to Allah SWT. In studying and understanding the contents of the book of the Qur'an, he always believed in the *apostle* of Allah, and felt peace in Islam.

The last stanza "*Rasool Allah, Habib Allah I really love you*", tells that he really *loves* Prophet Muhammad, as a Muslim must keep a sense of love to the Prophet. By showing his love to his Rasul, he never left his teachings that always order to believe in the religion of Islam that makes life peaceful and closer to Rasul and God.

It is being an obligation for every Muslim to love the Prophet, exceeded his love for all beings. In fact, love the Prophet SAW is called *ushul faith* (principal *belief*) in Islam. It means that it is closely coupled with the love of Allah Sw. The love to Allah must be greater than the love to people and the other creature in this world. Allah says : "*If fathers, children, brothers, wives, relatives, wealth which you try, commerce you worried losses, and dwellings you love, is more love of Allah and His Messenger and strive in the way, then wait until Allah*

brings about His decision. "And Allah will not guide those members who wicked", (Surah At-Tauba: 24)

Prophet Muhammad also said; *"Do not believe (perfectly) any one of you before me (the prophet SAW), more than love to his parents, his children, and the whole people:"*(HR. Bukhari and Muslim)

Therefore, it is mandatory for us as Muslims to prioritize and put our devotion to Allah and His Messenger above the love for yourself, children, relatives, family, and property.

C. DISCUSSION

This section discusses about the findings of the data analysis. With the result of the data analysis above, the researcher justified in the song lyric Harriis J of moral value namely: religiosity, love and affection, loyalty, sincerity, ¹²thankfulness, steadfastness, humbleness, peace loving and respecting others. And the result is 21,05% of "love and affection" as the most frequently used of moral value and 2,63% of "respecting others" as the least frequently used in the song lyric.

Based on the previous study created by Arista NikenKartika Sari, there are types of moral values, those are: religiosity, love and affection, loyalty, sincerity, thankfulness, steadfastness, humbleness, peace loving, brotherhood, respecting others and optimism. And the result are 13 of "religiosity" as the most frequently used of moral

value and 1 “humbleness and peace loving” as the least frequently used in the song lyric.

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter discusses the result of the analysis. The researcher will try to make a conclusion and a suggestion in the last chapter of this research based on the analyzed data above.

A. Conclusion

After the researcher observe with the discussion about “AnAnalysis Of Hariss J Song’s Moral Value on Song Lyrics of Harris J“,the researcher gives a conclusion that can be explained below. Finally, after paraphrasing the songs the researcher found several moral values in Harris J songs they are Salam alaikum, Worth it, I promise, The One, Good Life and Rosull.

1. *Salam Alaikum song*, this song is about spreading peace and compassion to everyone by saying sallam. Salam does not mean merely an expression of love, but provide the reasons and logic affection embodied in the form of a prayer of hope that you are safe from all kinds of grief-suffering. Moral values that existed there is about peace loving, thankfulness, peace loving, and respecting other.
2. *Worth it*, this songisabout fighting for his dream and trying to make it happen. Because to get a good result, it takes hard work and sacrifice of everything including the time to get together with friends. But to get good results and it deserves to be tried, pray and surrender to god. Because we do seriously and believe that god will surely give the appropriate we want

and hope. Moral values that existed there is about optimism, religion, steadfastness and sincerity.

3. *I promise*, this song is about ears of a child wholeheartedly promised to do his best for his parents because he realized his parents had been doing everything the best for him. He vowed to do everything as well as possible, as good as his parents had done for her. Moral values that existed there is about humbleness, love, affection, and religiosity.
4. *The one*, this song is about believing to no other god but Allah. He just believed in god and he asked for help and gain strength to live her life for Allah always guide his flock is best for him. And he believed that the god always give the best for him in his life he was always closer to the god to worship him because he's always believed only to him he asked for help and the only god who can help when he had problems in his life. Moral values that existed there is about thankfulness, optimism and thankfulness.
5. *Good life*, this song is about telling expression of thanking god by giving her the best life, learn to accept life from the gift of god and always being thankful and he always surrender to the God of life and always be grateful as he has always learned to accept life both good and bad for he believes Allah always gives their best.
6. *Rosul Allah*, this song tells about the Prophet Muhammad one Rasull god who spreads the religion of Islam which teaches about the religion of Islam and he is not only closer to god, he also believes in god Rasull in command by Allah to spread the religion of Islam. No exception truth
