CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter the researcher would give conclusion and also suggestion related to the research findings and discussion of the researcher

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings and discussion described and analysed in the chapter IV, the researcher finally comes to the conclusions concerning with the topic of the thesis, the conclusions are as follow:

- 1. From the findings and discussions, my conclude that the writers of the soundtrack of *Moana* use figurative languages in their writing. The researcher finds at least ten kinds of figurative languages of the twenty kinds of figurative languages proposed by Nyoman as the main reference of this study. They are Personification, Simile, Hyperbole, Symbol, Metaphor, Parallelism, Alliteration, Repetition, Para Rhyme, and Irony. Meanwhile, the figurative languages Apostrophe, Synecdoche, Metonymy, Paradox, Understatement, Oxymoron, Allusion, Onomatopoeia, Tautology, and Litotes were not found in the findings, it might be both of those figurative languages are more suits with the nature of such literary work for instance in the written Massa media such as newspaper.
- 2. Then the researcher found that Repetition is the kinds of figurative languages that is mostly used in the soundtrack of *Moana*. It seems to

dominate he usage of the figurative languages in the soundtrack of *Moana*, with the percentage of 13 lyric.

- 3. From the study of the related literatures, there might be some reasons why the writer of the song in the soundtrack of *Moana* to use figurative language in their writing:
 - a. The message which is delivered by the writer will be clearer and strict
 - b. The appropriate choice o figurative languages might make the readers to have more interest in reading to the writing.
 - c. Sometimes it just makes things easier to understand.
 - d. The figurative languages compress a lot of meaning into a few words.
 - e. The figurative languages can make speech or writing more affective, it beautify and emphasize the meaning.

B. Suggestion

Based on the entire presented, the researcher would give some suggestions as follow:

1. For the students

The researcher of this study hopes that study can be a good contribution and reference for the students who want to do further research or learn more on the topic of figurative languages. Since it is now clear that the figurative languages is not only limited to the field of Literature but also can be used as a main theory in a linguistics research for the students who are interested in.

2. For the teacher

Related to the contribution to the English teacher, it is hoped that this study can be a complement for other literary studies especially about figurative languages, when teaching listening, writing and reading.

3. For the researcher

The writer has some suggestions related to the subject of research for the next researcher, because my research study is actually still far from being perfect, so it can be continued. In addition, the result of the study can give contribution to others and give advantages to all people that they have intention to learn about live through work of art.
