

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter deals with conclusion and suggestion of this study. The researcher describes short explanation about the result of this study, and the researcher draws the suggestion related to this research

A. Conclusion

Based on the result of the data analysis, the respondent produced 723 sentences. 534 sentences for stage two, 43 sentences for stage three, 35 sentences for stage four, 30 sentences for stage five, and 77 sentences for stage six. Although the respondents could acquire the syntactic structure in stage six, but they could not acquire stage three and four, even several respondents did not produce the utterances in that stage. The researcher draws final remark that the use of the framework *English Second Language Acquisition: syntactic structure, which was conducted by Pienemann, Johnson, and Brindley 1988* is not compatible to the EFL learners, especially eighth semester students of English Department. This is also a true thing that the result of this study showed quite differences of the research that was done by previous researcher who made the framework.

B. Suggestion

The researcher draws the suggestion of this research based on the result of analysing the data.

The following points deal with the suggestion for the lecturers, the students, and next researchers:

1. The lecturers

Because almost half of respondents could not acquire the some stages of syntactic structure, the lecturers can evaluate what subjects should be revised in order to produce the good quality output. It is about improving the students' skill especially in structure and speaking skill. It is applied to all degrees of English department faculty.

2. The students

The result of the study showed that many syntactic structures and grammatical error occurred. This should not be happened because the incorrect word order and grammar are simple structure. Therefore, the writer hopes that the understanding of structure (syntax) of the learners will gradually improve and the students of English department should get more practice in structure.

3. Next researchers

This study needs more verification, because the framework used is not compatible with the learners of English department. Thus, the researcher expects that next researchers can continue this study by using another framework.
