

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter contains conclusion and suggestion related to the the research findings. The conclusion is taken from the research problems and the findings while the suggestion is intended to impart information for the next related research.

A. Conclusion

Here is the table that shows the amount of comments observing and infringing the Grice's maxims in cooperative principle conducted in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post. From five issues within twelve days, the number of comments gathered is 53 comments presented as follows:

The results of the research show that there are all maxims which are observed and infringed in *text your say*. The reasons for the number of observances and infringements of maxims from the above comment-data table are classified into four:

1. The number of comments observing the Grice's maxim of quantity is strictly lower than the number of comments infringing the Grice's maxim of quantity. It is because the comment-imparting people give inappropriate information (to show what they really want to say rather than to fulfill the requested comments) or give more information than is requested. From the 53 comments, there are 21 observing comments and 32 infringing comments.
2. The number of comments observing the Grice's maxim of quality is strictly lower than the number of comments infringing the Grice's maxim of quality. It is because the comment-imparting people form accusing opinions that lacks of enough evidence or use some figures of speech. From the 53 comments, there are 18 observing comments and 35 infringing comments.
3. The number of comments observing the Grice's maxim of relevance is strictly higher than the number of comments infringing the Grice's maxim of relevance. It is because the comment-imparting people's contribution is appropriate to the immediate needs at each stage of the transaction. From the 53 comments, there are 32 observing comments and 21 infringing comments.

4. The number of comments observing the Grice's maxim of manner is significantly higher than the number of comments infringing the Grice's maxim of manner. It is because most of the comment-imparting people are educated people therefore the educated people are easy to transfer ideas into written comments. From the 53 comments, there are 42 observing comments and 11 infringing comments.

The result of analysis shows that most comments in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post do not match the cooperative principle and also infringes one or some of the maxims while there are only eleven comments (5.3.2, 6.4.3, 8.5.1, 9.5.1, 9.5.2, 9.5.4, 10.5.1, 11.6.1, 11.6.3, 11.5.4, and 12.7.4) which observe the maxims from 53 comments available within 12 days from December 3, 2012 to December 15, 2012. Therefore, the data show that most comments in '*text your say*' are inappropriate to the cooperative principle and its maxims because the comment-imparting persons observe one or some maxims of cooperative principle and infringe one or some maxims of cooperative principle.

B. Suggestion

Knowing the results of the research, the researcher gives some suggestions stated below:

- The comment-imparting persons should not only read the black-blocked title of issues but also read the requested question in order to be able to give an appropriate and informative response in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post.

- The comment-imparting persons should have reasons to form valuable opinions in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post rather than to form accusing opinions that lacks of enough evidence
- The comment-imparting persons should focus on the discussed topics rather than to impart inappropriate responses therefore the dialogue, between The Jakarta Post and the comment-imparting persons in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post can run well.
- The people who impart cooperative comments should keep being cooperative and get better and better again.
- This writer conducts the research of comments in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post in general to classify observance or infringement of the Grice's maxims and possibly later there is related research that can discuss comments in '*text your say*' of The Jakarta Post deeper about violating, opting out, faced by a clash and floating based on the Cooperative Principle and its maxims.
