ABSTRACT

Key Words: stress pattern and speaking ability

This study is aimed to know the stress pattern that produced by the English students of STAIN Kediri. Stress is divided into two that is word stress and sentence stress. However, each stress has some categories, like word stress has the category of two-syllable noun, verb, adjective, suffix and prefix. Sentence stress also has its category that is category of functioned as complement, subject, verb and object. Therefore, in this case, the researcher is wondering to know the stress pattern produced by the English students of STAIN Kediri. The research design of this study is descriptive qualitative. The researcher uses data redundancy to take the sample of the research in order to make the maximal data and information of the study.

The instrument of the research is researcher herself because she does not use any other instrument. She looked for the data by using audio-visual recording. She interviewed the respondent as natural as possible while they did the conversation because she wanted to get the original data. Hence, the researcher used speaking to analyze the stress. The data source of the research is the students' utterance. Therefore, she used mobile phone, digital camera and laptop as the tool for encouraging the research.

The result of this research found the stress pattern that produced by the English students. To discover the stress pattern, the researcher should analyze the stress interference. As the result, found Word stress and sentence stress. There are four category of word stress, the category of two-syllable noun, the category of two-syllable verb, then is the category of two-syllable adjective and the last is category of word containing suffix and prefix. Mostly, the stress pattern that made by the respondents happened because misplace the stress. For the sentence stress, the interference most commonly produced is the category of functioned as subjective complement, the second is functioned as direct object, then the category of functioned as verb, next is the category of functioned as subject and objective complement and the last category of functioned as indirect object.

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
