

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion. Conclusion relates to the problem of this study and also to the objective of this study which is about “Using Direct Method to Improve Pronunciation Accuracy of the Eighth Grade Students of MTsN 5 Kediri-Balong”. Meanwhile, the suggestion is based on the research finding, discussion, and conclusion of this study.

A. Conclusion

Direct method could be implemented by using some techniques, like reading aloud, conversation practice, and student self correction. It could develop the students accuracy in their pronunciation.
