

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presented conclusions and suggestions from research conducted by the researcher on improving students' speaking skill in presentation using TEDx Talks YouTube video as media at SMK Negeri 2 Kota Kediri, especially in class XI majoring in Accounting 3 (AKL 3).

A. CONCLUSION

This Classroom Action Research was carried out on class XI Accounting 3 students at SMK Negeri 2 Kota Kediri. It was carried out on October 18 and ended on October 31, the odd semester of the 2023 academic year. All stages of action research have been completed. The main problem to be solved in this research is that students' speaking skill scores were below average compared to other skills, and this is caused by students' bored in following the process of learning speaking skill in class, there were no activities to practice speaking, and this make students' pronunciation not fluent. Therefore, the researcher provides a solution that motivates students majoring in Accounting 3 (AKL 3) class speaking skills at SMK Negeri 2 Kota Kediri.

The aim of this research was to improve students' speaking skill in presentation using TEDx Talks YouTube video as media in the teaching and learning process. The results of the research and discussion in Chapter IV show that students' speaking skill in presentation regarding the use of TEDx Talks YouTube video media in

the teaching and learning process in class XI Accounting 3 at SMK Negeri 2 Kota Kediri have increased. Actions were carried out in two cycles. The results of this research show that it was successful.

The results of cycle 1 have an average score of 64.64, the percentage was 38.23%. Apart from that, there were thirteen students, or 38.23%, who met the completeness criteria for test 2 (cycle 1), and 61.77% of students did not meet the completeness requirement score, which was set at a score of 75. The results of cycle 1 did not meet the completeness requirements, so researcher continued to the next cycle. Based on the results obtained, there were twenty-six students, or 76.47%, in cycle 2 who met the completeness criteria. The results of cycle 2 meet the requirements for the completion criteria of 75%, in accordance with the specified success criteria. There is no doubt that asking students to discuss topic based on TEDx Talks YouTube video that have been shown can help them improve their speaking skill in presentation.

B. SUGGESTION

After conducting detailed research, the researcher concluded that the practice of "discussing video" can help students improve their speaking skill in presentation. To keep students involved and interested in speaking activities, teachers are advised to use various media in class, one of these media is "discussing TEDx Talks YouTube video" which can be used to attract students' interest and attention to speaking fluently and effectively.
