ABSTRACT

The ability to understand written language is known as reading. Reading aims to understand the reading passage or derive factual knowledge from it. The teacher's simple directive to read and respond to questions without providing clear guidance or comprehension practice is one of the reasons why students need help understanding passages or texts. Reading *Guide Strategy* is a learning strategy that emphasizes step-by-step support or assistance in learning reading comprehension. This study is to find out whether there is any effectiveness of using scaffolding model to teach reading comprehension on narrative text. This research aimed to know whether using the *Reading Guide* strategy can improve students' reading comprehension in descriptive text.

The research design used in this research is Classroom Action Research (CAR). The research is conducted in 3 tests: preliminary test, cycle I, and cycle II. The object of this research was the students of XI-E MAN 3 Kediri. The researcher used observation, tests, and documentation to collect the data. This research was conducted with the approval of the English teacher of MAN 3 Kediri.

The data provided by the students' average test results on the preliminary test, cycle 1 to cycle 3, indicate this. The average score of the preliminary test was 54.72, the average score for Cycle 1 was 67.78, and the average score for Cycle 2 was 80.139. The study's conclusion regarding the problem—namely, how the *Reading Guide* strategy can help students' reading comprehension—is that, by create an assumption about the text, present it, and draw on any past knowledge.
