

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion of the research to answer the statement of the problem and suggestion for the reader and next researcher.

A. Conclusion

This study is concerned to the use of politeness strategy by focusing on the utterances used by Nina Sayers as a female main character and Thomas Leroy as a male main character in Black Swan movie script. The aim of this study is to find out what kind of certain politeness strategy usually used by two main characters in conducting communication to other characters in the Black Swan movie. The results of the analysis are presented as follow:

1. The writer found 87 utterances containing politeness strategy used by Nina Sayers. They are bald on record strategy about 10% (9 utterances), positive politeness strategy about 54% (47 utterances), negative politeness strategy about 19% (16 utterances), and off record strategy about 17% (15 utterances). Then, 43 utterances containing politeness strategy used by Thomas Leroy. There are percentages of each strategy used by Thomas Leroy. They are bald on record strategy about 26% (11 utterances), positive politeness strategy about 51% (22 utterances), negative politeness strategy about 16% (7 utterances), and off record strategy about 7% (3 utterances). Those percentages show that Nina Sayers and Thomas Leroy

preferred positive politeness strategy to other strategies in conducting communication with hearers.

2. The writer found that the positive politeness strategy commonly used strategy notice and attend to hearer's wants used by female main character and strategy use in group of identity markers used by male main character. The reason why they commonly used this strategy is positive politeness as a kind of social accelerator, where speaker in using them indicates that he wants to come closer to hearer. The strategies that the characters used, Nina and Thomas, have been socially and culturally accepted because what they speak is appropriate to the situation of the culture when the utterances produced. What links these strategies to their verbal expressions is exactly the same kind of means-ends reasoning.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion, the researcher gives some suggestion. This suggestion to enrich the study of politeness, those who are interested in studying politeness can use some other theories like Lakoff's, Leech's, and Scolon's. In addition, the three sociological factors (relative power, social distance, and ranking of the imposition) are also can be related for those who wants to make a wide research of politeness.
