CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

The last chapter lead the research to the conclusion and suggestion. The conclusions present the summary of the research findings related to the formulation and objectives of the research. After reviewing and explaining some terms related to direct and indirect speech act based on searle's categories of context. in addition, this includes positive and negative politeness based on Brown and Levinson's strategy in "The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies" movie script. The researcher comes into the last discussion. Here, the researcher will explain the conclusion and the suggestion, and would like to draw the conclusion as follows:

A. Conclusion

From the analysis about direct and indirect speech act based on searle's categories of context include positive negative politeness include based on Brown Levinson's strategy in "The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies" movie script. The researcher finds two categories, first category of function and category of context. Based on searle's category of context, there are two parts: they are direct and indirect speech acts. Meanwhile, the researcher also finds four strategies based on Brown and Levinson. Both of them are positive and negative politeness.

In addition, based on the finding the data and discussion in chapter IV, the conclusion can be explained as follows:

The first conclusion refers to the finding and discussion, the researcher found 89 direct speech act and 15 indirect speech act in *The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies*" movie script. The second conclusion related to the finding and discussion, the researcher found 14 positive politeness and 15 negative politeness act in *The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies*" movie script.

B. Suggestion

The researcher deals with the analysis of direct indirect and also positive negative politeness in the movie " *The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies*". Movie is used as an object of the research by the researcher because direct indirect speech act and positive negative politeness ideally appear in a speech or conversation. Or often used in a movie or another long conversation. The analysis and the findings, the researcher suggests some matters to the students of the English Department who major in linguistics and to other researchers in the same field. The suggestions are presented in the following.
