CHAPTHER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter provides information of some points including, background of the study, problem of the study, the object of the study, significance of the study, scope and limitation of key terms.

A. Background of the Study

The role and influence of English today are gaining a higher speed in the world. The main factors for this phenomenon include expanding communication with the world after gaining independence and increasing speed and scope of information exchange in the global village. The dominant position in the internet space by the language of the published content is firmly held by English, which is a strong motivation to learn English for those who wish to promote their global competencies.

the speaker's message, regardless of grammatical accuracy. In addition, a good discussion allows the audience to express their reactions while also getting feedback from the speaker.

Effective speaking skill are really important for a teacher in transmitting of education, classroom management and interaction with students in the class. Teacher has to teach the students having different thinking approaches. To teach in accordance with the ability and capability of the students a teacher need to adopt such skills of communication which motivate the students toward their learning process (Sng Bee,2012).

The ability to communicate is an important condition in the learning process as it can help and facilitate students to express ideas, as well as exchange information with teachers or fellow students. This passive learner is not involved in the learning process so when asked his argument in the discussion process the attitude shown among others is less confident because of fears his argument is wrong, behave stupidly because there is already a friend who answers questions, until in the end the student does not really understand the material so making his learning results to be low. Conditions like this are caused by a lack of connected communication. Teacher-centered learning will make teachers dominate learning activities by giving more of the concepts that are relevant without deepening their meaning.

The goal of teaching English in an Indonesian environment is to assist students in improving their reading, speaking, listening, and writing abilities in the language. Even though children in our nation have studied English for at least three years (from junior high to senior high school) we still discover that their proficiency in the language is lacking. For instance, the majority of the students at MAN 1 Ngnajuk still have a low level of proficiency in English, which makes it difficult for them to pronounce words correctly and use proper vocabulary when speaking. Teachers can use group discussions as a teaching approach, and students can learn from them. Weissberg (1988) claims that the best way to improve oral language abilities is to divide the class into focus groups for discussion. It It is anticipated that oral conversation in groups will help students' English speaking abilities. Because it provides students more time to share their ideas and facilitates more animated debates, it is more effective.

Based on the researcher observation and preliminary from the class, when the teacher gave task about speaking English words, the students still could not pronounce well even though the teacher already applied an interesting technique in the classroom. From preliminary in class 11 MIPA 3, which consisted of 34 students, only 6 students scored above *Kriteria Ketuntasan Maksimal* (KKM). Therefore, researcher believe that using the grup discussion method can improve students' speaking. Related to above, researcher is interested in using group discussion, especially group discussion as an alternative way to practice speaking. With group discussion will be very helpful to teach vocabulary because in this students can learn some vocabulary. In English language teaching is very beneficial in improving students' concentration and making them happy in learning English.

From the explanation above, the reseacher conducted a study entitled "Improving Students' Speaking Skill Through Role Group Discusion In Merdeka Curiculum At Eleventh Grade Student Of MAN 1 Nganjuk".
