Speaking is a skill that allows us to express ourselves and share information, the same like writing. The ability to speak requires engaging in the mental process of thinking, as we need to organize our thoughts and communicate effectively. One of ways to have good speaking English, students must increase their listening habit. Speaking and listening have a necessary role in learning English, if only speaking without listening carefully it will not function properly or listeners will get misunderstanding.

This study aimed to find out the correlation between students' habit in listening to English song and their speaking skills of the first grade students at MTsN 9 Kediri. This study used a questionnaire and a test. Questionnaire was used to get the score of students' listening habit, while test was used to get the score of students' speaking skills. The population of the study was all of the first grade students while the sample was 31 students and it was taken by purposive sampling technique. To analyze the correlation, researcher used Pearson Product Moment with SPSS 25.0 for windows.

From the research finding, it was found that the significant value between students' habit in listening to English song and their speaking skills was 0.00. It can be said that there was a significant value between listening habit to an English song and speaking skills. The result of the computation showed that the correlation coefficient (r) of both variables was 0.699, it means that there was positive relationship between students' habit in listening to English song and their speaking skills of the first grade students at MTsN 9 Kediri.
