A. Background of the Study

Speaking is a skill that allows us to express ourselves and share information, the same like writing. The ability to speak requires engaging in the mental process of thinking, as we need to organize our thoughts and communicate effectively. It is strengthened by Channel (2011) people will share meaning by producing and receiving information through verbal and non-verbal symbols in a variety of context. For this reason, researcher conducted this study was to determine the significant correlation between students' habit in listening to English song and their speaking skills that conducted in the first grade students at MTsN 9 Kediri. B. Research Question
