This interactive engagement suggests that Chatbots are not just passive tools but actively involved in students' learning experiences, making the process more engaging and enjoyable.

Secondly, regarding proficiency enhancement in English, the findings indicate significant improvements in various language skills, including conversation comprehension, reading, writing, and vocabulary aspect. Students report an overall increase in confidence, especially in their speaking abilities, due to the immediate feedback provided by Chatbots. This regular interaction simulates real-life conversations. While many students would love to use digital tools like Chatbots for learning, some students still value traditional teaching methods for their human element and emotional nuances.

Thirdly, despite the positive reception, some challenges in using Chatbots were noted. Although the majority of students considered chatbots to be engaging and user-friendly, some issues, such as the quality of prompts, relevance and updated sources, and data security concerns, are highlighted. These challenges underscore the need for critical engagement with chatbot technology.
