ABSTRACT

Writing is one of the skills where we have to express the ideas we have with proper grammar, punctuation, syntax, and spelling. Students sometimes struggle to write, especially when writing an foreign language. Many students have difficulty producing accurate and meaningful writing recount text because English is foreign language and difficult for students to learn; students face a lack inspiration and motivation. This study aims to investigate the effectiveness of using animated video to teach recount writing skill for eighth grade students of MTsN 5 Kediri.

There was a control group and an experimental group in this quasi-experimental study design. For teaching students how to write recount texts, the researcher applied PowerPoint in the control group and animated videos in the experimental group. In this study, 58 students from two classes participated. There were 29 students in class VIII-D, which was the experimental group, and 29 students in class VIII-C, which was the control group, all of them from MTsN 5 Kediri. Tests were used for collecting data, including writing pretest and posttest. The data was analyzed using ANCOVA in the SPSS 25.

The analysis of the data showed a significant difference between the experimental and control groups' pre-test scores and the experimental and control groups' post-test scores. The experimental group's pre-test mean value was 58.10, whereas the control group's pre-test mean value was 57.93, while the control group's post-test mean value was 73.87, whereas the experimental group's post-test mean value was 85.17. furthermore, the ANCOVA result revealed that (p) was 0.00. So, in this research H1 is accepted because p is less than 0.05 and H0 is rejected. According to the calculation results, animated video was effective in teaching writing recount for junior high school students, especially those in the eighth grade students at MTsN 5 Kediri.
