

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter focuses on conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion based on the analyzing the data and the statement of problem. The suggestion are given to the teacher, student, reader and next researcher.

A. Conclusion

This study investigated the figurative language used in song lyrics related with humanity for Palestine. Furthermore, this study also tried to find the humanity values in song lyrics related with humanity for Palestine. The result of the data analysis showed that there are nine types of Figurative Language refers to Kennedy's Theory. They are Hyperbole 7 song lyrics, Metaphor 5 song lyrics, Personification 4 song lyrics, Simile 2 song lyrics, Litotes 1 song lyrics, Irony 6 song lyrics, Synecdoche 1 song lyric, Metonymy 2 song lyrics, and Symbolism 2 song lyrics. In every song lyrics related with humanity for Palestine have some humanity values there are self confidence, enthusiasm, strong believe, scarifying for other, bravery , sincerity found in moral values , love found in family values, voluntarism found in national values and faith found in spiritual values.

B. Suggestion

From this research, students can learn more about figurative language material to improve their analytical skills, especially through song lyrics. Songs make it easier for students to learn related material in English, where they can choose what kind of songs to apply in practice by more closely examining the figurative language in each song.

For the teacher, this research can help them understand the definition of each figure of speech, understand the use of figurative language in song lyrics, and be their

guide to identifying figurative language easily. so that from these guides, teachers can ask and help their students practice more closely examining the figurative language in each song lyric, which can improve their abilities in analyzing.

For researchers, this research can contribute to the scope of English, especially for the Department of English in Literature. In addition, this research still needs to be expanded because it only includes figurative language found in song lyrics related with humanity for Palestine without further research implications. It suggested that future researchers should also focus on the elements of other people's songs, not only figurative language but also the meaning of the whole song. This study is also expected to be a reference in the field of English Language Studies especially for English Department in the literature area.
