CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter is an introduction to the study and consists of the background of the research, research questions, objectives of the research, significance of the research, scope and limitations of the research, and definition of key terms.

A. Background of the Research

Language is a means of communication in the social, political, economic and educational fields. English is very important in the business world and almost everyone uses English to communicate (Liando, Palenkahu & Mongkarem, 2021). English is taught in Indonesia and many schools and programs teach English. When learning English, students need to master listening, speaking, reading and writing (Lengkoan et al., 2022).

In other words, it is impossible for people, especially students, to understand spoken or written language without acquiring vocabulary.

Vocabulary is very important. Young children need to have a good grasp of vocabulary because it affects the acquisition of language skills such as listening, speaking, reading, and writing. According to Hatch & Cheryl (1995), vocabulary refers to a list or collection of words in a particular language or the list or collection of words available to speakers of that language. Furthermore, Read (2000) defines vocabulary as an inventory of individual words and their assigned meanings. Furthermore, Ur (1996) argues that vocabulary can be broadly defined as the words taught in a foreign language. However, new vocabulary can consist of two or three words and can be multiple words

expressing one idea. This could mean that all languages are made up of combinations of words.

English teachers are expected to be able to help students improve their ability to use a foreign language. Therefore, teachers must have the right media to deliver lessons to students. In this study, images were chosen as the media because they are more interesting to students and make it easier for them to understand the message. Hornsby explained that using visual media can make students more interested in learning. Teachers can use any visual media such as flashcards, paintings, sketches, and other works of art.
