

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After discussing the result of the analysis, the researcher would like to conclude and make suggestion in the last chapter of this research.

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the the speech acts used by students of *English Department'11* in their facebook conversation, the researcher categorize the speech act from Austin's theory. Austin substituted a three-way namely locutionary, illocutionary, and perlocutionary acts. The researcher found five category of illocution speech acts by Austin. They are expositives (conducting of arguments), verdictives (giving a vredict), behabitives (attitudes, thank), commissives (promise) and exercitives (order or designate). The total number of facebook conversation is 35 items. Based on the findings, she found that the most dominant categorize is expositives 21 items, verdictives 8 items, commissives 2 items and the last exercitives 1 item.

The realization of the speech acts in the conversation can be seen from the IFIDS. The categories of IFIDS used as the realization of illocutionary acts are directive mood is 9 items, interrogative mood 8 items, performative mood 7 items, intonation 1 item, the mood of the verb 5 items, assertion 4 items, and word order 1 item.

The result of the data analysis above shows that the students of English Department'11 used facebook to clarify status or comment, expounding of view

arguments and offering something. In IFIDS, the students who update status order her friends to join in completion, to read some article and request to do something.

B. Suggestion

After analyzing the category of speech acts, the suggestions are directed toward the students and the next researcher.

1. For the students

Based on the research, many students who use facebook to inform or conduct of arguments. It can be developed so facebook more useful, for example, by writing article or an essay in order to increase our knowledge in English language skills. We can ask friends to comment on our posts and correct each other. We can share about anything as long as good. After graduated, we can share information about job.

2. For the next Researcher

Based on the result of this research in the analysis of speech acts, it can be suggested that this research can be discussed from other topics by the next researcher, for instance by using other theory, not only facebook conversation. It will be more attractive to compare with theory speech acts by Sadock or Searle.
