

ABSTRACT

Reading has a vital role in providing knowledge to students, but many students get bored when reading a text. In this study the researcher used a random text strategy to facilitate students' reading comprehension. This research aims to determine the impact of using random text strategies in learning narrative texts that focus on students' literal understanding.

The type of research design used is quasi-experimental research consisting of an experimental class and a control class. The experimental class was taught using the random text strategy and the control class was taught using the lecture method. Researcher used a claster sampling technique. The research samples were classes X-2 and X-5 of SMAN 1 Purwoasri, each with 34 students. Researchers used narrative text material as a test. In this study, researcher conducted a trial first to determine validity and reliability, then carried out a pre-test before and a post-test after treatment was given to both groups. 20 multiple choice questions are used for the test. After getting the pre-test and post-test data, the data were analyzed using SPSS 26.

The result showed that average pre-test in experimental class was of 54,85 and the control class was of 52,81. Apart from that, the average post-test score for the experimental class was 75.00 and the control class was 72,94. The result of ANCOVA showed that the significant value is 0,000 (p< α 0.05). The findings of this research indicate that the random text strategy has an impact on improving students' reading comprehension. This means that the alternative hypothesis is accepted and the null hypothesis is rejected. Apart from that, the reading comprehension obtained from the random text strategy is literal comprehension (inductive information, main idea and supporting idea). From the results of statistical calculations, it can be concluded that the random text strategy is effectively used in teaching narrative texts to improving students' reading comprehension and can be used as an alternative in teaching reading, especially in senior high schools.
