

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, based on the research and discussion in previous chapters, the writer offers some conclusions and suggestions as well.

A. Conclusions

This research used design R&D (research and development) and the ADDIE development model. In research conducted at SMPN 2 Ngadiluwih, developing a vocabulary on an e-booklet was carried out through several stages to analyze target needs. After collecting the data, the researcher developed a vocabulary e- booklet as supplementary material for seventh-grade students. The researcher draws several conclusions based on the findings and discussion as follow :

1. English Vocabulary in Context: Practical Examples and Exercises was developed as supplementary material for seventh-grade students to learn vocabulary. For developing the product, use the ADDIE model's five phases: analysis, design, development, implementation, and evaluation. In the first phase, the researcher analyzes the student's needs and collects data from an observation sheet, questionnaire, and interview. In the second phase, the researcher designed the product using the app BookCreator. Then, the researcher developed the product from design, which is the third phase. In the next phase, the researcher gave the product to three experts to validate. After that, the researcher has revisions to validate. In the fourth phase, the product was implemented for students to know their opinions about whether the product was to be realized for the students or not. After

that, the fifth phase is evaluation, in which the researcher can be presented to students for independent learning.

2. The name of the product is English Vocabulary in Context: Practical Examples and Exercises, which focuses on vocabulary material. The product is used for seventh grade as supplementary material, like an e-booklet, so the students can learn English independently. The material in this supplementary material is related to descriptive text but focuses on enhancing vocabulary. The supplementary material includes materials, examples, exercises, and a glossary.

B. Suggestions

1. Students
