CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter contains the background of study, research problem, research objective, significant of the study, limitation of the study and definition of key terms.

A. Background of Study

Nowadays, we can find people who are bilingual in society. It is not rare to hear people switching their language while speaking. In 1998, Spolsky defined that bilingual is a person who possesses some functional abilities in second language. Usually, they change their language from mother language to another language to define or tell a word that is difficult to explain in their mother language. Thus, people use "code switching" to make easier in explaining things. Code switching is a term from sociolinguistic field. People can use code switching in many situations, conditions and places. The use of code switching can be executed by anyone, regardless of age. The common phenomenon of code switching usually occurs in bilingual or multilingual community.

As Indonesian, we learn English because English is a language that should be learnt in our curriculum. It makes us categorized as bilingual or multilingual people. Being bilingual or multilingual people mean we speak more than one language. Since we have ability to speak more than one language, we tend to mix the languages. A condition where we speak more than one language and mix them is called "Code Switching". Code switching is also used in school to help both teacher and student in learning activity.

We could find bilingual or multilingual people anywhere. Especially in Indonesia, people speak at least 2 languages: Indonesian language and local language. Bilingual people can be spotted on TV, our surroundings, social media, or we can even consider ourselves as a bilingual person if we speak more than one language. There are also VTubers who speak more than language and it is common to find them using mixed languages when talking in their streaming.

Kureiji Ollie is an Indonesian VTuber associated with Hololive. According to the official website, her debut date was on 4 December 2020. She is the part of the second generation of Hololive Indonesia. Her virtual persona has zombie-like appearance. She is known as a hyperactive zombie. Ollie is fluent in Indonesian,

Japanese and English. It is shown in some of her videos that she talks not only in Indonesian. The interaction between Ollie with the viewers or with her collaboration partner is quite interesting too. Due to her popularity, she gained 1 million YouTube subscribers on 24 March 2020. There are two reasons why the researcher chose Kureiji Ollie. First, Ollie can speak more than one language: Indonesia, English, and Japanese. Second, Ollie often switches between two languages: Indonesia and English. In other words, she meets the requirements of this study, namely a bilingual who code-switches.

Based on the background explanation above, the researcher is interested to know about the types and the reasons for code switching used by the Virtual Youtuber Kureiji Ollie. Therefore, the researcher decides to conduct descriptive qualitative research entitled "An Analysis of Code Switching Used by Kureiji Ollie on Her YouTube Channel".

F. Definition of Key Terms

In this section, the researcher describes about the term of this study to give more explanation about the content of this study. The definition is as follow:

1. YouTube

YouTube was launched on February 14, 2005 by Steve Chen, Chad Hurley and Jawed Karim. It is a popular social media and online video sharing owned by Google. There are more than one billion of YouTube users over the world. The number of viewed videos are more than one billion hours each day. YouTube can be used by people who have different ages. It can be accessed through PC and mobile. It provides various videos, such as videos made by content creators, the clip of movies/films, music video, educational video, entertainment videos, and many more.

2. Code Switching

A situation where there is someone who speaks more than one language. The change of language in a certain situation is called "Code switching" in sociolinguistics. Code switching frequently occurs between people who are capable to speak more than one language.
