ABSTRACT

One of the speaking activities that enhances communication competences is Information Gap Strategy. This strategy, students have to use the language to share the knowledge. The purpose of this study is to investigate the methodological approaches offered by the Information Gap Strategy and to know the effectiveness of students who are taught by using Information Gap Strategy to enhance students' speaking skill at the tenth grade of SMAN 1 Nganjuk. and the effect on the students' speaking performance were discussed in the research.

This study used a quantitative method with a quasi-experimental design. The subjects of this study were students of class X SMAN 1 Nganjuk. The two classes selected as samples were X MIPA 7 as the experimental group consisted of 35 students and X MIPA 10 as the control group consisted of 36 students. During the data collection process, both the experimental group and the control group were given a pre-test and post-test. The results of the pre-test and post-test were tested by using ANCOVA in SPSS 25

. The results of the data analysis in this study found that Information Gap Strategy has a significant influence to enhance the speaking skills of students of class X MIPA 7 SMAN 1 Nganjuk. The significant results obtained were p $(0.000) < \alpha$ (0.05), this indicates that with the data that has been obtained, the null hypothesis in this study is rejected and the alternative hypothesis is accepted. These results indicate that Information Gap Strategy is an effective learning method for enhancing students' speaking skill.
