CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the general description of this study. This chapter has seven points, those are background of the study, problem of the study, objective of the study, significant of the study, the hypothesis of the study, scope and limitation of the study, and definition of key terms.

1.1 Background of The Study

English as an international language has an essential role in the world development. People are competing to be productive in world level. Hence, understanding English is important because it is necessary in communication, research and study, and technology. People are also thinking that if they are not understanding English, they will not be able to compete the development and following the era.

Moreover, trust in their own ability possessed and believe in getting success as known as self-efficacy is also important for students to have.

Furthermore, this is very interesting when a high school have other way to overcome students' lack of confidence. Based on student's problem in reading, this study aims to find the correlation between Self-Efficacy, Self-Confidence and English reading achievement of second grade students of senior high school. Hopefully, the results of this study can beneficial for the students to gain more confidence and have the feeling of Self-Efficacy to help them in improving the level of reading to face the future.

1.2 Problem of The Study

Based on the background of the study above, there are problems that should be taken to consider: To what extent is the correlation among Self-Confidence, Self-Efficacy and the English reading achievement of second grade students of MAN 3 Nganjuk?

1.3 Objective of The Study

From the statement of the problem above, the researcher can set up the objective of the study is to know the extent of the correlation between Self-Confidence, Self-Efficacy and English reading achievement of second grade students of MAN 3 Nganjuk.

1.5 Hypothesis of The Study

- 1.5.1 There is a positive and significant correlation between Self-Confidence and English reading skill of second grade students of MAN 3 Nganjuk.
- 1.5.2 There is a positive and significant correlation between Self-Efficacy and English reading skills of second grade students of MAN 3 Nganjuk.
- 1.5.3 There is a positive and significant correlation among Self-Confidence and Self-Efficacy with English reading skill of second grade students of MAN 3 Nganjuk.

1.6 Scope and Limitation

Using the scope and limitation of the research is essential in order to be more focus. In this research, the researcher limits the study as follows:

- 1.6.1 The subject of this study is the Self-Confidence and Self-Efficacy of the second grade students.
- 1.6.2 The object of this study is MAN 3 Nganjuk.
- 1.6.3 The researcher uses the instrument test and questionnaires.

1.7 Definition of Key Term

1.7.1 Correlation

Correlation is a connection between two or more things that will be correlated. The correlation in this research means whether there is connection or relationship among the Self-Confidence, Self-Efficacy and the English reading achievement of second grade of MAN 3 Nganjuk.

1.7.2 Self-Confidence

Self-Confidence is someone's belief and trust to do something successfully. It becomes the one of factors in enhancing the skill to be better. When people have a lack of Self-Confidence they probably cannot reach the goals that they struggle for. Self-Confidence also impulses the eager to finish the work completely.

1.7.3 Self-Efficacy

According to Bandura Self-Efficacy refers to an individual's belief in his or her capacity to execute behaviours necessary to produce specific performance attainments. He mentions that Self-Efficacy as one's belief in one's ability to succeed in specific situations or accomplish a task.
