# CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

#### A. Research Background

It is inevitable thing which people cannot avoid it, whether if person against with their around or against with him/her self. People also choose the best solution of their problems. There are many conflicts happen

to her, especially the psychological conflict. She cannot do what she wants or she has to do what she does not want.

Shirin-Gol's problems are appropriate with a psychological conflict theory by Kurt Lewin (1948). He stated that the intrapersonal conflict has three types, such as *Approach-Approach Conflict, Approach-Avoidance Conflict, and Avoidance-Avoidance Conflict.* Since the definition of psychological conflict is person against him/herself, it shows that what Shirin-Gol can do and what she cannot do is from her decision. In this situation, she tries to decide what the best for her and her family around the difficulties. Although she will has a highly stressful situation to decide what she is going to do and become a mad after she does it. But she does not have a choice, or the situations around her do not give a chance for her.

This novel shows the main character's efforts to hold the better life from unpleasant condition and situation. Those Shirin-Gol's efforts is appropriate with the Mental Toughness Theory by Peter Clough (2001). He stated that MT is number of personality characteristics, which include persistence, resilience, confidence, and discipline. Due to that, person who is mentally tough has a high self confidence and

unshakable faith to overcome the conflicts (Clough et al, 2002: 38). It is obtained from some aspects, such as personality, attitude and values of individuals and/or environment. In this situation, what the person has to deal with is his/her own self, so the conflict resolution better that occurs from his/her own self too. A high self awareness makes person confidently take many challenge of life. Not only that, but person also will bravely to commit with him/herself to make a better life, even though it is so difficult and many pains happen.

This novel contains woman's courage, struggle and determination which represent most of the women in Afghanistan. #### F. Definition of Key Terms

To make the study and to loss misunderstanding or interpretation between the writer and the reader, the writer clarifies the terms are used in this research as follow:

- 1. Novel based on John Peck and Martyn Coyle is one of the forms in literature which looks at people in society. It happens because the writer always interested in the world around them, their new interest in the complexities of everyday experience. So, talking about novel is talking about the structure; a society, and characters that are in some ways at odds with this society. Those two structures run according to the plot created, which make the story unexpected. Moreover, the important thing about the novel is the message they preach, so that the story must have a point and a purpose. (Peck & Coyle, 1984: 102-103)
- 2. Psychological conflict or Intrapersonal Conflict is a situation where oppositely directed, simultaneous forces of about equal strength occur in a person. This is the condition when person has difficulty in making a decision because of uncertainty or if a person is pushed or pulled in opposite directions. (Lewin in Rahim, 1948: 97)
- 3. Mental toughness or described mentally tough individuals as tending to be sociable and outgoing as they are able to remain calm and relaxed, they are competitive in many situations and have lower anxiety levels than others. It measures how effectively individuals respond to stress, pressure, and challenge. Mental toughness would appear to incorporate aspects of both commonly recognized sports psychology interventions, such as focusing and visualization, and a number of personality characteristics, which include persistence, resilience, confidence, and discipline. (Clough et al. 2002: 38)

4. Novel Afghanistan, Where God Only Comes To Weep is one of the Siba Shakib's achievement after her several documentaries and films. It published in 2001 after she has experienced to travel to Afghanistan many times in recent years. She interested in making a documentary life in Afghanistan and the plight of the Afghan women. This is a novel of an Afghan woman who must have more courage to face many challenges in her life among injustice conditions and situations of war. The story has set in 311 pages and 18 chapters which tell about the main character's struggle to get a better life with well education, dedication, and persistence. (Shakib: 2002)
