

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter deals with conclusion and suggestion of this research. The researcher presents the conclusion of this research which gives short description and the result of this research. Then, the researcher also presents the suggestion related to this research.

A. Conclusion

All types of illocutionary acts were found in novel *The Perks of Being a Wallflower* by Stephen Chbosky, such as representatives, commissives, directives, declarations and expressives illocutionary acts.

Representative is usually used to state what the speaker believes to be the case or not, commissives is focused on committing the speaker to some future course of action, directives express the speaker's desire and become the reason for the hearer to act, declarations is used to declare something, which might change the world, and the last one is expressives which show what the speaker feel, such as dislike or disagreement toward someone or something in expressives for attitudes.

In communicating in the daily life, especially based on the conversation obtained from the novel, the participants in the novel used different ways to convey their message. Some of them used direct form, or they preferred to speak by means of something else or indirectly.

In the novel, the researcher finds many types of illocutionary acts which have meaningful message. There are 59 representative, 15 commissives, 11 directives, 12 expressives, and 8 declaratives. Based on social function of illocutionary acts found 33 asserting, 9 indicating, 1 admitting, 13 informing, 1 describing, and 1 swearing. Asserting, indicating, admitting, informing, describing, and swearing are kind of representative which mostly found. It means the writer describes about what happen with him. So, the writer conveys his belief that what he feels is true. While based on implicit meaning, many kinds of form in each types of illocutionary. Because of every people have different meaning in their utterances.

B. Suggestions

After the researcher presents the conclusion of this research, the researcher will give some suggestions related to this research. The suggestions are useful for student, lecturer, next researcher, speaker and listener. The suggestions are as follows:

1. For Student

For the students, they can improve their knowledge about speech act theory and know how the way to analyze it. They also can take benefits from the content of the utterances to take into consideration to contribute success in life. They can take implicit meaning of each type of illocutionary acts although every people has different meaning.

2. For The Reader

For the reader, they can know about utterances that contains about illocutionary acts. And know about implicit meaning. Many people have different meaning about an utterance. But it will make the reader interesting in read the novel.

3. For Next Researcher

For the next researcher, they can use this research as a reference for further study in the same subject. They can complete their analysis. And they can get ideas in doing their research. Maybe the researcher can take same topic but different analysis. The next researcher can use analysis in locutionary acts or perlocutionary acts.
