

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

Based on the description presented in previous chapter, conclusion and suggestion are presented in this chapter.

A. Conclusion

Based on the result of the research above, it can be concluded that respondents show a positive response towards the use of online learning. The respondents mentioned that E-learning is needed in the middle of the pandemic. E-learning is easy to access because it can be accessed whenever and wherever. Therefore, E-learning is efficient because it facilitates them to access learning material and submit tasks easily. The respondents participated in this study agree that the E-learning system is user friendly, they have adequate technology that is used to access E-learning and they can use it. They think that the use of E-learning is innovative idea and must be encouraged. In addition, they want to use E-learning for future studies. The respondents feel confident to learn using E-learning. Through E-learning, respondents can increase motivation in learning, and they can control their own learning. However, most respondents mentioned that they cannot decide whether E-learning can increase their learning effectively or not. They also cannot decide whether they like learning by using E-learning or not.

The implementation of E-learning, respondents feel that there is no interactive communication between teachers and students. Teacher

instructions are difficult to understand and cause misunderstanding between teachers and students. In addition, respondents do not feel comfortable and do not enjoy learning using E-learning. They also feel that the use of E-learning cannot increase their productivity in learning. The respondents feel that E-learning is not fun to use. Also feel confused and make errors frequently when using the E-learning system. In the availability of internet access, respondents still have a problem with the internet connection. Besides, the use of E-learning requires more costs.

B. Suggestion

Based on the result of this research, the researcher would like to give some suggestions, those are:

1. For the Teachers and Lecturers

Teachers and lectures should look at the learners' financial condition, availability of Internet access for students, and selection of E-learning applications that are effective and efficient to the implementation of E-learning. Teachers and lectures need to be more interactive in communication during the learning process.

2. For the Students

E-learning is really needed for now, students are expected to keep their enthusiasm for learning. The students should be active participants in learning although through E-learning, and they should have some effort to learn at home.

3. For the Next Researcher

Further research on this topic is highly required, with different respondents or different areas to explore more, not only about students' perceptions but also about parents' perceptions and how the educational institution prepares to welcome changes in the learning process in the classroom to e-learning.
