CHAPTER V

CONCLUSSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter provides conclussion and suggestion. After analyzing the data about discourse markers in "The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe" novel, the researcher present the conclussion and suggestion.

A. Conclussion

Based on finding and discussion, the researcher concludes as follow:

- 1. There are four types of discourse markers that are used in novel "The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe" by C.S Lewis according to Frasers' theory. They are contrasitive discourse markers, elaborative discourse markers, inferential discourse markers, and temporal discourse markers.
- 2. Based on research finding above, the researcher found 27 statement of contrasitive discourse markers, 38 statement of elaborative discourse markers, 7 statement of inferential discourse markers, and 27 statement of temporal discourse markers. So, the dominant types of discourse markers that are used in this novel is elaborative discourse markers, its because the frequency of this type was 38 times.
- 3. There are four meaning of discourse markers words: 27 statements are classified as contrasitive discourse markers because they indicates contrastive words, 38 statements are classified as

elaborative discourse markers because they indicates connecting word and adverb, 7 statements are classified as inferential discourse markers because they indicates as conclussion word and also 27 statements are classified as temporal markers because they indicates as adverb of time and conjunction.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclussion above, the researcher gives some suggestion as follow:

1. For the reader

The researcher expect this study will be benefical for the reader, especially who are interest in novel, they should recognize and know the utterance conveyed by the characters of novel. So, they can catch the implicit meaning of the sentences. In addition, they should know the part of speech in any utterance used by the character of novel.

2. For the next researcher

This study is expected to give benefical contribution and relevant reference for the next researcher who will analyze the same case, make them give explanation about discourse markers and have new idea about analysis in discourse markers. It can be a textbook, song, speech, talkshow and anything else.

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
