

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the background of the study, research problems, the objective of the study, the hypothesis, significance of the research, scope and limitation, definition of key term

A. Background of the Study

Speaking is a productive skill that can be seen directly and observed empirically (Brown, 2004). Speaking learning activities are dedicated to students directly to express and communicate in terms of sharing ideas or exchanging opinions. Mastering speaking skill is very important for a successful foreign language learning (Alqahtani, 2015). Therefore, mastering speaking skill becomes an indispensable requirement for those who want to be able to learn English well.

One of the places to learn English is Junior high School. And one of them is *MTsN 5 Nganjuk*. The learning of English speaking skill is a preference for a lot of English as Foreign/Second Language (EFL/ESL) learners. Language learners sometimes evaluate their success in language learning based on how well they have improved in their spoken language ability. Teachers and textbooks use either direct approaches that concentrate on particular aspects of oral interaction such as turn-taking and topic management or indirect approaches which make situations for oral interaction by group work, task work, and other strategies Richards (2001).

different reasons like emphasis on grammar and unfavorable teacher-student proportions. Speaking test approach uses a general scale to give a single global rating for each test-takers language production Djwandono, (2008). Speaking is a skill which is worthy of attention in both first and second language. Learning the speaking skill is the most important aspect of learning a second or foreign language and success is measured based on the ability to perform a conversation in the language Nunan (2005).

The purpose of teaching speaking is to communicate efficiency (Brown, 2001:271). Students must understand to avoid confusion of pronunciation, grammar, or wrong speaking. They must practice intensively so that they can use English communicatively both in oral and written form. However, the problems are that students only have limited time in learning to speak English in class. Outside the classroom their encouragement to learn English is lacking. These cases bring the problem about their difficulty in learning to speak English. Tarigan (1990) argues that speaking remains the most difficult skill to be mastered by most English language learners.

A research shows that students essentially revel in the same thing in making use of their speaking capabilities. that is based on a studies carried out by way of Nurhayati (2016) showing students experience embarrassed when they have to speak in front of the class, and they are fearful of making errors whilst expressing their thoughts in interacting with others because they do not know how to bring them. In addition, they felt that their speaking capability become no longer first-rate due to their lack of mastery of speaking and learning techniques that had been no longer appropriate for them. To conquer these issues,

there must be new approach to assist college student beautify their speaking.

This tale completion is one of the alternative techniques.

student to learn English. One of them is the story book method. According to Malu (2012) picture storybooks are books with pictures and text that together tell a story with an appropriate theme for children. In short, picture storybook is a book of one or more stories with pictures and text that together tell a story in a certain theme. These books are created to help the beginning reader read independently with success.

By using picture storybooks in a class, the teacher can enhance students' attention. If students pay attention to a topic of material that their teacher explains, they will understand it easily. Al-Somadi (2012) they have limited text on each page, large print, double spacing, and short sentences.

Dealing with that issue Mitahul (2013) says the use of picture storybooks can give great help to the teacher in the classroom. A student cannot always successfully learn English just by listening to the teacher or by reading many books on English lessons. However, it does not mean that reading books or listening to the teacher is not necessary for them. Therefore, the researcher uses one of the media to teach, for example, pictures in teaching speaking to the students of the beginner level.

B. Research Problem

C. The Objective of the Research

D. The Hypothesis of Research

E. Significance of the Research

The research gives some useful information about the effectiveness of using picture storybook on students' speaking mastery. Hopefully, the result of this research is useful for teachers, students, and other researcher. The result will be used for the following:

1. for teachers

2. for students

The writers hope that the other teacher can follow this technique to prove student speaking. Improving speaking also can comprehend all skill in English.
