

CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter is divided into two major parts. They are conclusions and suggestions. The conclusion section explains the research findings related to the research problem. The second part contains the suggestions for lecturers, students, and future researchers.

A. Conclusion

This study aims to investigate student's perception toward english e-learning during covid-19. Based on the results of the research, the data were grouped into three indicator (Robbins, 2003); understanding, acceptance and evaluation.

In the understanding indicator, the results show with the average score 81%. The study also found that student's perception toward english e-learning during covid-19 in acceptance indicator with the average score 77%. Furthermore, student's perception toward english e-learning during covid-19 in evaluation indicator with the average score 74%. From these three aspects, student's perception toward english e-learning during covid-19 are at the high level of interest with the average score 77%. Students think e-learning is quite fun. They have many advantages. E-learning can motivate learning as well as increase student activity in the learning process.

B. Suggestion

The suggestions are given to the lecturers, the students, and also for the future researchers who are interested in conducting this similar topic.

The first suggestion is for lecturers. Based on the findings of the research, e-learning is a fairly effective learning media used for learning. So it requires more innovation in its development. It is expected that lecturers will apply other applications so that learning will be more varied.
