#### ABSTRACT

From 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020, the Minister of Education and Culture of Republic of Indonesia has ordered all education units to run online learning due to the increasing spread of COVID-19 and maintaining the health of students, teachers, and all educational staffs. It fully replaces face-to-face learning in classroom setting into online learning which possibly lasts until the end of semester due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It becomes a new challenge for both students and teachers to run online learning.

In order to examine the English teachers' challenges and strategies especially the interaction, the researcher takes data from SMP Negeri 1 Wonodadi, Blitar. The instruments used were observation and interview. The interaction or teacher's role in interactive teaching categories was taken from H. Douglas Brown. The researcher observed and interviewed two teachers from SMP Negeri 1 Wonodadi, Blitar.

The result of this research is the most challenging problems or challenges that the English teachers face in rural area during teaching in pandemic situation is they cannot fulfil their role as controller and manager, especially, they cannot control their students' conversation. From that issue, teachers still do not find strategies or problem solving to solve the issues. The most second challenging problem for English teachers in rural area is their role as director. Teachers cannot keep the process of learning smoothly and effectively. Teachers also cannot find strategies for this challenges. Besides, teachers also face several challenges as manager which they have to make a lesson plan well. It is because they have to adapt with the new condition, thus they need to rearrange their lesson plan. But, as time goes they are able to make a lesson plan well during Covid-19 pandemic. After that, teachers cannot fulfil their role as facilitator since they have been teaching online, but they use internet sources to support their learning process. In the last challenge as facilitator, namely as resource, in fact, they are always be ready if their students come to them to ask questions or when they need help or feel confused with the lesson, but their students hardly ever come to them.
