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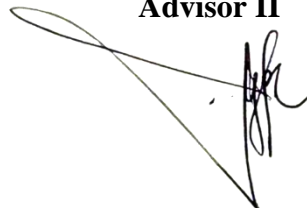

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ABSTRACT

Based on the curriculum syllabus, high school students must master descriptive paragraphs. In class X SMA students must be able to make descriptive paragraphs about tourist objects or historical sites. To achieve this achievement, students found it difficult because in developing descriptive paragraph writing, they must master the concept of descriptive text, make paragraphs, and have sufficient vocabulary to develop good descriptive paragraph writing. Therefore, researchers were looking for an effective method to improve students' writing skills, and the technique was suggestopedia and picture. Here, the researcher wants to provide an overview of the application of suggestopedia to teach descriptive writing to students of different genders.

This research used a quantitative approach, and the design was a quasi-experiment. The suggestopedia method was applied in the experimental class. In comparison, the picture method was for controlled class. In carrying out this study, the researcher conducted the research at SMAN 1 Nganjuk from the 1st of March to the 29th of April 2022. The population was the tenth graders students. The total numbers of students in the tenth graders are 332 students, and it used two classes as the sample. The experimental class consists of 36 students, and the controlled class consists of 35 students. Female students are 58, and male students are 18. To get the data, the researcher conducted a pretest and a post-test. For research, the researcher carried out four meetings, a meeting for the pretest, doing treatments twice and one day for the post-test. He analyzed the data by using SPSS 22.

Based on the results of data analysis, using SPSS showed a difference in the average value of 3.93, where the average value of the experimental class was 83.34, and the average value of the control class was 79.41. The difference in the values above after being analyzed by SPSS showed a significant difference in the significance level of .05. The above descriptive means that the suggestopedia method is more effective than the picture. Overall, among 53 female and 18 male students involved in the study, there was a difference in the achievement of 6.13, or about 7.98% of female students were better at writing descriptive text. After doing the test calculations, the analysis of variance where the significance value obtained is 0.551 greater than 0.05 concluded that there is no interaction between the learning models and gender on the results of student achievement in writing descriptive text.
