

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The objective of this study are to examine the students' ability and problems with essay writing by third semester English Department students at IAIN Kediri in the 2021/2022 academic year. There are five categories that were assessed. There are five of them: content, organization, grammar, mechanics, and vocabulary. Based on the research findings, the writer concludes that:

1. The mean scores of third semester English Department students at IAIN Kediri are 61.77. It means that the students performed on fair level. The fair level interval score is 59-73.
2. The research findings also revealed that students still have problems in essay writing. The percentage of students who have a problem with organization (18.80 percent), content (18.80 percent), grammar (21.05 percent), mechanics (21.80 percent), and vocabulary (18.80 percent) (19.55 percent).

B. Suggestions

Here are some ideas that can be shared and hopefully benefit anyone who reads this "thesis." The following are some ideas:

1. For the teachers
 - a) Lecturers should explain the general structure of the text more thoroughly, especially in essay writing.

- b) The lecturers should explain mechanics and grammar more thoroughly. As a result, students can improve their writing skills by using proper grammar.
 - c) The lecturers should give more exercise to the students.
2. For the students
- a) Students should write more to improve their writing skills, particularly in essays.
 - b) The students should study mechanics and grammar more.
 - c) Students should be motivated to learn English.

Hopefully, after reading this thesis, other researchers will take the information contained within it and improve it so that the end result will be more useful in improving the English learning process.
