CHAPTER I

As shown by Pinter (2006), young learners have a strong intention to start new experiences and explores concrete to abstract concepts. The study of Riyani (2019) showed that utilizing finger puppets as a platform for storytelling is helpful for teaching vocabulary since it allows students to conveniently learn new language. Whereas the use of storytelling with puppets in teaching vocabulary had the advantage of keeping students excited and not sleepy during the learning process.
