CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

There are two things covered in this chapter, conclusion and suggestion. The conclusion will be based on the research findings and discussion above. Then, the suggestion will leads the further researcher on the same fields.

A. Conclusion

From the finding and discussion it can be conclude that the lyrics used by the author in album *Constellation* are mostly the result of her personal experiences. Inevitably, language learners will learn more about semantic knowledge through contextual and lexical meaning. The use of contextual and lexical meaning is various; it is caused by the experiences of the author in applying her mind into the language differently to see the condition that occurs in song.

In this album also found several types of contextual meaning. They are 2 or 6% context of organs, 11 or 34% context of place, 4 or 12% mood context, 2 or 6% context of time, 8 or 24% context of purpose, 6 or 18% context of situation. Context of place is the most dominant contextual meaning which used in Stars and Rabbit's *Constellation*. The least contextual meaning that is used in Stars and Rabbit's *Constellation* are context of language, and object context. Contextual meaning and lexical meaning they have contrasted meaning. Contextual meaning very interesting to discussed than lexical meaning because its can to bring out many perspective.

B. Suggestion

By considering the conclusion, there are some suggestions. For the next research, there is a limitation of this study that the future research may continue it, so the study can better than current research. This study examined only a part of the song. So that, the next research may analyze the contextual and lexical meaning in a whole song. To the readers if want to know more about contextual and lexical meaning, it's need critical thinking so that there are no mistakes when capturing the context of a language. To the students of to apply similar analysis on other text, for analyzing a song based on types of contextual and lexical meaning can improve student ability in understanding of meaning and to broaden prespective.
