

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the researcher presents the conclusion of the findings in this study. The suggestion is also provided to the further researchers and the English students.

A. Conclusion

Based on the findings and the discussion that are presented in the previous chapter, the conclusion of this study is as follow:

1. The first objective of this study is to know what types of illocutionary acts that are applied in the speech of Noam Chomsky entitled 'What Everyone Needs to Know about Covid-19'. In this study, the researcher found 4 of 5 types of illocutionary acts, they are assertive or representative, directive, expressive, and declaration. Commisive types were not found in Noam Chomsky's speech since the speech is a monologue that is created to inform people about Covid-19. Since this research found 65% of utterances that are included in assertive or representative type, so that the dominant type that are appeared in Noam Chomsky's speech is assertive or representative. It could be happened because the speech of Noam Chomsky is a speech with a purpose to giving the information about Covid-19.
2. The second objective of this research is to know what functions of each types that are appeared in Noam Chomsky's speech. There are 3 functions included in assertive types, 6 functions included in directive types, 2 functions

included in expressive types, and 2 functions included in declaration types. The most frequently function which used in Noam Chomsky's speech is reporting with the percentage 31,06% or 41 utterances. Its is reasonable since the speech of Noam Chomsky contains a lot of information.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion that have been explained above, some sugestions would be directed toward English students and other researchers.

1. For the Students

This study can be used by students to understand how pragmatics is applied in daily life utterances. It is important to know the intended meaning behind in an utterance. So that the misunderstanding can be decreased or even avoided.

2. To the next Researcher

The researcher expects the result of this study may provide benefits to the future researchers who are interested in conducting pragmatics study, particulary illocutionary acts. It is also suggested to enlarge and develop the study by investigating all types of speecha acts or another branches of linguistics field since this study has not explore them yet.

3. For Readers

Based on the result of this study, readers are expected to be more open-minded in understanding the meaning of language used on Noam Chomsky's speech contextually. Furthermore, readers are epected to learn how to understand the deep meaning in utterances spoken or written.

Moreover, readers are expected to understand what Noam Chomsky will convey through this research
