CHAPTER VI CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents two parts, there are conclusion and suggestion.

Conclusion part consists of concluding of this research and suggestion part consists of suggestion based on this research.

A. Conclusion

According to the finding and discussion section in previous chapter, it concluded that most of conclusion sections of undergraduate thesis in each paragraph and sentence of the analyzed data there are elements that indicate that the text is cohesive and coherent. It is marked by several signs which indeed show a coherent and cohesive nature.

In the coherence of a text, the cohesion device here has an important role. In their work, the grammatical cohesion device that they use the most is the conjunction device with a total of 83% (2819) usage, and in the second position there is a reference device as much as 16% (541) use, while for ellipsis and substitution devices the percentage is very small., even for the ellipsis device is not at all in.
