

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents conclusion and suggestion that are divided from the research findings.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

There are several conclusions drawn from the research problem as follows:

1) students' problems in writing argumentative texts (2) the students' strategies in developing their ideas in writing argumentative texts.

##### 1. The students' problem in writing argumentative text

Based on the findings, the researcher can draw conclusions about the problems faced by the students of SMK Pawiyatan Daha 1 Kediri in writing argumentative texts; students are lack of vocabulary mastery, lack of grammar skills, lack of skills in developing ideas, and lack of motivation to understand a structure.

##### 2. the students' strategies in developing their ideas in writing argumentative text.
