CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presented the conclusion and the suggestion of this study.

A. Conclusion

Based on the research findings, it is found there are six politeness strategies used by teacher consisting of 12 kinds of the tact maxim, 2 kinds of the generosity maxim, 32 kinds of approbation maxim, 2 kinds of modesty maxim, 41 kinds of agreement maxim, and 3 kinds of sympathy maxim. While the politeness strategies used by the students are four politeness strategies consisting of 1 kind of the tact maxim, 1 kind of modesty maxim, 37 kinds of the agreement maxim, and 3 kinds of sympathy maxim. Thus, the total data found was 132 politeness strategies analyzed by Leech's politeness principles.

Furthermore, the researcher concluded that the most frequent politeness strategies used by the teacher and students were the agreement maxim because it has the highest frequency than the other strategies with the total data 41 times used by the teacher and 37 times used by the students.

B. Suggestion

Based on the conclusion above, the researcher hopes that this research can be used as a reference for the next researcher and other readers such as a teacher. Here are several suggestions pointed to:

1. The next researcher

The result of this study can be used as a reference in pragmatics studies related to politeness strategies used by the speaker and the hearer in communication. The researcher suggests for the next researcher develop this research not only limits the analysis on the types and what are common types of politeness strategies used, but also analysis of the types of impoliteness strategies because it is often found in the practice. Besides, the next researcher can also apply the latest theories on the politeness speech act.

2. The readers

The result of this study may useful for the readers to know what kinds of politeness strategies to be applied in daily life. Throughout this study, the researcher hopes the readers will be more understand the way to build good communication without offending others. Besides, the researcher also hopes the readers can develop their languages use by studying linguistics.
