### **CHAPTER V**

# **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## A. Conclusion

Discourse Analysis is concerned with the study of the relationship between language and the context in which it is used. Language aspect that used by people in the area of discourse analysis are also discussed in the area pragmatics. Pragmatics is concerned with how the interpretation of language depends on knowledge of the world. Pragmatics is interested in what people mean by what they say, rather than what words in their most literal sense might mean by themselves. A further key notion in pragmatics which implication for both the production and interpretation of discourse is the concept of conversational implicature. Conversational implicature refers to the interference a hearer make about a speaker's intended meaning that arises from they use of the literal meaning of what the speaker said, the conversational principle and it's maxims.

According to Grice there is a general cooperative principle between speakers and hearers which controls or guides the way they speak. The cooperative principle consists of four maxims with their sub maxims. The four maxims are: the maxim of quantity, the maxim of quality, the maxim of relation and the maxim of manner. There are two types of conversational implicature, generalized and particularized conversational implicature. Based on the finding and discussions described and analyzed in the previous chapter. The researcher comes to the conclusion concerning with the topic of thesis. There are any two types of conversational Implicature that produced in talk show "Bonansa English Show". There are 16 Utterances which are categorized as generalized conversational implicature. Generalized conversational implicature produced by announcer and guest in Bonansa English Show. And then the particularized conversational implicature, there are 11 utterances found from the data. Particularized conversational implicature is often used by announcer and guest in Bonansa English Show when they are presenting program of talk show.

The generalized and particularized conversational implicature contains a maxims that amount 44. There are 4 types of maxim that produced by announcer and guest in Bonansa English Show. Maxim quality produced by announcer and guest in Bonansa English Show is 7 utterances found from the data. Maxim quantity produced 12 utterance, and also 17 utterances of maxim relation in Bonansa English Show. And there are 8 utterances of maxim manner produced by announcer and guest of Bonansa English Show.

## **B.** Suggestion

Based on the entire chapter presented, the researcher gives some suggestions:

# 1. Teachers

The researcher suggests the teacher to give motivation for their students to use English language not only in the process of teaching leaning but also in doing daily activities. Discourse analysis can be used in our daily activities, we can know the meaning of our conversation, that is called conversational Implicature. So, the teacher can give a motivation for their student in the school or campus outside around it

#### 2. Learners

The researcher suggest who learn discourse, especially conversational implicature to think more critically about the other interesting phenomena in spoken discourse existing in society. In addition, they should be understandable and more attention in spoken English.

### 3. Other Researchers

The result of the research can be used as a reference to next researchers who are interested in further development of this matter. It is expected that the further researcher will be better than this one. In this research, the researcher focused on the announcer and guest's utterances during four talk show.
