## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSSION AND SUGGESTION**

## A. Conclusion

After conducting research by examining the metaphorical sentences contained in the book "*The Little Price*" and obtaining the results in the findings, the researchers came to the conclusion that the researcher found there are metaphorical sentences are in accordance with the theory that the researchers used in chapter two, namely Ullmann's theory (1964). Researchers have found forty eight data with three types of metaphors from the four types of metaphors contained in the theory of metaphorical sentences found in the book including, first is eighteen data of anthropomorphic metaphor that discusses about comparing inanimate objects with parts of the body, senses, or feelings in humans, second type is there are three data about sentences a synesthetic metaphor that talks about comparing one human sense with another human sense, and finally there are twenty six data about abstract to concrete metaphor sentences that talk about comparing something that is inanimate or inanimate with something concrete or animate. The kind of animal metaphor that talks about comparing other things to animals is not found in this book.
